End of the activity and shuttle back to the official hotels from the pickup point.⁽³⁾



Information about the museum

REINA SOFÍA MUSEUM

The Museo Nacional Centro de Arte Reina Sofía (MNCARS), commonly called Museo Reina Sofía (Reina Sofía Museum) is a Spanish museum based in Madrid that specializes in showcasing 20th century and contemporary art works.

It is located in the old General Hospital of Madrid, a stunning neoclassical 18th century building in the Atocha neighborhood, close to the train station of the same name and the Arte Subway Station. The hospital was first designed by José de Hermosilla and later on continued by Francesco Sabatini. For this reason, it is known as The Sabatini Building in honour of the Italian architect. The museum was inaugurated in 1992.
