Dr. Jae Woon (June) Lee is an Assistant Professor in the Faculty of Law, the Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK). Born in Seoul and educated there as well as at McGill University and National University of Singapore, Professor Lee teaches aviation law and competition law. He has been working, teaching and researching in the field of aviation law and policy since 2004.

He has seven years of legal affairs experience in the airline industry. Since 2012, he has been a legal consultant to Korea's Ministry of Foreign Affairs on aviation law and policy issues. He was a legal advisor to the Korean delegation at the ICAO Legal Committee and Diplomatic Conference in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2018.

Professor Lee authored the 2016 book Regional Liberalization in International Air Transport: Towards Northeast Asian Open Skies. He has published extensively on a wide range of issues relating to aviation law and commented in media including Channel NewsAsia and the South China Morning Post. He frequently presents at academic and aviation industry conferences. He is currently working on a book project: "Aviation Law and Policy in Asia: Smart Regulation in Liberalized Markets" (under contract with BRILL).
