

Katsuhiro Yamaguchi Visiting Researcher University of Tokyo

Mr. Katsuhiro Yamaguchi is currently Visiting Researcher at the Graduate School of Public Policy (GraSPP), University of Tokyo. He served in Ministry of Transport (reorganized as MLIT in 2001) of Japan from 1983 to 2017, during which he had broad and extensive experience in policy areas including air transport, inter alia air carrier regulation, aviation & airport policy as well as public transit, railway, automobile and logistics. He has also served as Professor at GraSPP between 2005 and 2008. Between 2012 and 2016 he served as Executive Officer of New Kansai International Airport Company Ltd. (NKIAC) tasked with corporate strategy, international affairs and airport privatization. He served as Director General of East Japan Civil Aviation Bureau, MLIT from 2016 to 2017.

He holds LLB from Faculty of Law, University of Tokyo (1983) and MBA from Graduate School of Business Administration, University of Michigan (1990).

He has published a number of academic papers regarding air transport and high-speed rail in major academic journals as well as papers for OECD/ITF, ICAO etc.
