## ICAO TRIP assistance project in the Sahel

“Strengthening Travel Document Security and Identification Management in the Sahel and neighboring States”

- **Budget:** \$750,000 (CAD) - Funded by the Government of Canada, Counter-Terrorism Capacity Building Program
- **12 Beneficiary States:** Algeria, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Chad, Guinea, Mali, Mauritania, Morocco, Niger, Nigeria, Senegal and Tunisia
- **Implementation Period:** April 2014 to March 2016
- **Implementation Partner:** United Nations Counter-Terrorism Executive Directorate (UNCTED)

Participants to project activities are coming from Agencies in charge of:

- National identification management
- Travel document issuance
- Immigration control at borders

  - Train-the-trainer component



## Border control: Common main recommendations of the Gap missions

- **Recommendation #1**

*Should The state choose to proceed with the implementation of an ePassport, it must join the PKD. Becoming a PKD member prior to implementation would assist with the implementation of a PKI*

- **Recommendation #2**

*It is recommended that Immigration authorities proceed as soon as possible with the installation and operationalization of an API system based on UN/EDIFACT standard electronic manifests.*

- **Recommendation #3**

*It is recommended that the State initiates discussions with INTERPOL with a view to integrating SLTD information (using MIND/FIND) into a modernized border management system.*

- **Recommendation #4**

*There is an urgent need to expand current border system capabilities to allow for the reading of MRTDs at all ports of entry. For all documents, this will include the checking of any machine-readable security features and capturing the scanned image of the data page. It would also include an automated verification of the passport's ongoing validity (including the application of business rules i.e. minimum remaining validity required to grant entry).*

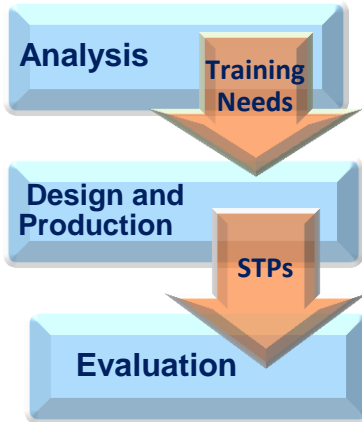
