

# Czech Republic (CZ)



- European Union (EU)
- Schengen Area (airport)
- Area: 78,864 km<sup>2</sup>
- Population: 10.5 m
- Foreigners: 437,858 (4,2%)
- Border Police:
  - Part of the Police of the Czech Republic
  - Executive police authority with nationwide scope of powers
  - Specialized, central, methodicallymanaging, expert, analytical, control and executive police authority in the area of alien matters and protection of external Schengen border



### Introduction

- CZ has 19 international airports, the Border Police is constantly present at 5 airports
- Biggest airport with more than <u>10.5 m</u> (2012) passengers p.a. is <u>Václav Havel Airport Prague</u> where <u>2.35 m</u> were potential users of the ABC system

# **Project Overview**

- Project name: <u>EasyGO</u>
- In official operation since Dec 5<sup>th</sup> 2011 one eGate
- Project has been extended by two eGates in Dec 2012
- Nearly <u>300.000</u> passengers have been processed (border crossings) between 12/2011 9/2013
- Process time: <u>Ø 16 sec</u>:
  - **Start:** Passenger placing eID document on passport reader
  - **Stop:** eGate is ready for next user
  - fastest border crossing was measured at **11 sec**.



### **Project Overview**

- Can be used by EU/EEA/CH citizens with ePassport
- Traveler has to be older than 15 (since Sep 2013)

- Biometric feature is FACE
  - System matches the face stored inside the chip against the face captured by ABC camera
- Biometric False Rejection Rate (FRR): 3.98 %



















#### Location – Terminal 1 - Arrivals






#### Location – Terminal 1 - Arrivals






#### Process Workflow






#### Statistics – Total Usage – 292,522





# Project Overview – Key Findings

- Mostly positive response from passengers
- The traffic peak hours have to be supported by staff assisting passengers
- Some passengers are afraid to use the eGate what a pleasant surprise <u>when it works</u>
- Handling and correct use of the ePassport is the key point:
  - o too many tries with the passport booklets
  - o passport is removed too early
  - correct interpretation of the MRZ





# **Operational Support**

- Regular evaluation of process data (monthly)
- Continuous training of police staff
- Periodic observation and analysis of passenger behavior during the border control process
- Continuous training of assistants (police & airport staff) – during the rush and operation hours there is always someone who can support passengers in using the ABC system





### Conclusion

- The received results and experiences create success story
- The excellent team work among all project partners allowed us to implement the solution efficiently and fast
  The system was installed within only five working days before the official start
- EasyGO has been awarded as IT Project of the year 2012 in the Czech Republic
