## **Role of Identity Management**

- Foundation Piece
  - Key to all transactions
    - i.e passports, visas, border control, aviation security
- Essential Element of Security
  - Do you really know who you are dealing with?



# Role of Identity Management (2)

- Criminal Activities
  - Human Trafficking
- Shift from Document Fraud to Identity Fraud
  - Use of biometrics in ePassports



## **Evidence of Identity**

- Identity actually exists
- Identity belongs to the person you are dealing with
- Identity is used in society

- A "Living Identity"



## **Identity Fraud**

- Several forms of Identity Fraud
  - Impersonators
  - Look-alikes
- Pressures on Human Resources



### **Past Practices**

- Reliance on Documentary Evidence
  - Breeder Documents
    - Birth certificates
  - Third Person declarations
    - Guarantors
- In Person Interviews



### Evolution

- Secure documents
  - More Secure Passports
  - Improved/Expanded Civil Registries
    - Links to Death Registration
- Social Footprint
  - Workplace, Finances, Residence
- Biometrics
  - Face, Fingerprint



# Evolution (2)

- No Single Source to Identify an Individual
- Use of Publicly Available Databases
  - Tax rolls, voter registration
- Security Assessment Tools

- Information Sharing
