increased.






PKD contributes to these goals


- Governments are looking for reliable and cost efficient border controls.
- Airports want fast control lines that don't take away valuable space.
- Citizen don't want to wait in line and they expect a benefit from the money governments invested in ePassports/eMRTDs, they want to travel safely.
- Not or too late detected falsifications of eMRTDs would lead to a massive loss of credibility with negative impact on future developments.


- A repository for:

- ICAO Master List (possible future development)








Where do these certificates come









 Project in 2006.




AND AUTHENTIC DOCUMENTS ONLINE

- Facilitate of controls of Swiss ePassport and the travel of Swiss Citizen around the globe.






Air Traffic Flow Chart 2012 INT (29,060 Routes)




2012: 2,500 Cities for 29,060 Routes INT and 10,343,060 movements.

- Over 76 % of ePassports are issued by PKD Participants = very high benefit for border control authorities. It covers a large part of the global air traffic

Finances

Registration fee (one time): USD 56'000

Operator fee 2014: USD 34'000 USD 11'295

Participation Fee 2014 USD 45'295

Operator fee reduction as of 1.1.2014: USD 34'000 (21 % reduction, compared to 2013)





PKD is in everybodies interest



Protecting the borders in a reliable, cost effective and fast way living up to the citizens expectations for facilitation & security – Need to detect falsifications to maintain trust.

Issuing Authorities interests in the PKD world wide recognition of a nation's eMRTD, allowing it's citizens to cross borders as easily as possible.

Carriers interests in the PKD
Check passengers documents appropriately.





Who should join?

- Decide on one responsible authority it doesn't matter which –
 this may be any national agency border guards/passport
 issuer/police and establish the connection with the PKD
- Import and export CSCA, DS, CRLs and Master Lists on a regular basis
- Distribute the downloaded certificates to the users (Border Guards, Police etc.)


