Aerospace engineer (ENSMA) with training in management of the International School of Management, Vincent Gorry is Senior Vice-President, European and International Affairs of GIFAS (French Aerospace Industry Association). He accompanies since 2007 the international development of the members of the Group of French Industrialists of Aerospace and Space (GIFAS), and, since 2010, also contributes to defending their interests at European level.

He began his professional career in 1990 as a space studies engineer on the European Ariane 4 rocket in its production phase on behalf of Aérospatiale, then in management positions on the development phase of the Ariane 5 launcher at Europropulsion, a joint subsidiary of Safran and Avio.

From 2001 to 2007, Vincent Gorry contributed to the international development of Safran: at first, by practicing in the International Affairs Department, at the headquarter; then by representing the group in India where he was, among other things, directly involved in setting up three industrial subsidiaries.

Vincent Gorry is, since 2009, member of the Board of Codifor, association for the promotion of international cooperation in the field of professional training. From 2010 to 2016, he was a member of the Board of ISAE-ENSMA, a French engineering school member of ISAE Group.
