
Results of 17 USAP Audits of the Second Cycle in the NAM/CAR Regions by Critical Element (29/02/12)

■ Group of 17 States average 38.8%


■ Global average 32.7%

Most Common Critical Deficiencies in the Region Based on USAP Audit Results



- **★** National level
 - **★** Lack of effective implementation of AVSEC oversight activities
 - **★**Qualification and Training of AVSEC personnel
 - **★** Lack of effective screener certification and approval of AVSEC Programmes
 - **★** Resolution of AVSEC deficiencies
 - ★Insufficient guidance material, performance criteria and procedures



Most Common Critical Deficiencies in the Region Based on USAP Audit Results



★ Airport level

- ★ Airport security programmes, training and quality control programmes not updated with current national regulations
- ★ Lack of an effective and harmonized application of passenger, baggage, cargo and access control security procedures

 - **★Insider threat**
 - **★**Risk-based measures
 - **★** Sustainable security measures
 - **★**Air cargo security
 - **★**Travel document security
 - **★**New technologies
 - **★**Information sharing/Intelligence
 - **★** Technical assistance/Capacity development
 - **★** Aviation security training

AVSEC Panel Meeting March 2012 Montreal, Canada






★ Principal results:

- ★ Unanimous consensus on amending/strengthening Annex 17 Standard 4.2.6 to address insider threat. The Panel voted to require that persons other than passengers be subjected to screening and security controls prior to entering Restricted Security Areas
- **★**Adoption of an Action Plan on Air Cargo Security
- **★** Evolution of the USAP towards a USAP-CMA strategy; proposal to ICAO Council during its 196th Session
- **★ICAO** to develop a risk-based approach to prioritize assistance
