1. Introduction

1.1 During ICAO's Tender phase (Sealed Tender ST-22501390), COMSOFT has already conducted site surveys in nearly all member sites.

2. Status Viewing

2.1 Nearly all Site Surveys are successfully done - only Venezuela is still pending, due to the following reason:

- <u>Venezuela</u>: Despite the current political and safety issues, COMSOFT is coordinating with the local partner to see when the Site Survey can be done.
- <u>**Recommendation:**</u> Based on the above mentioned situation and in accordance to the implementation schedule, COMSOFT recommends as alternative solution to perform the Site Survey by the Venezuela ANSP itself under supervision of COMSOFT by phone Clarification needed.

2.2 During the site surveys some MEVA III Member States were not able to provide status on the actual used interfaces and ownership of equipment. Such information is mandatory in accordance to the final network configuration and design – Clarification needed.

2.3 The current status and collected information from the site surveys of the MEVA III Network sites is presented as **Appendix** to this paper.

3. Suggested Actions

- 3.1 The Meeting is invited to:
 - a) review the site survey status and results as feedback for the implementation actions;
 - b) comment any local site requirements for the installation; and
 - c) inform of any changes for the information for contacting each MEVA Member
