#### Sir/Madam:

Following the regional priorities and targets implementation established for the air navigation areas: Air Traffic Management (ATM), Aeronautical Information Management (AIM) and Communications, Navigation and Surveillance (CNS), I wish to invite your Administration/Organization to participate in the Second NAM/CAR Air Navigation Implementation Working Group Meeting (ANI/WG/2) to be convened at Hotel Doubletree Resort Puntarenas by Hilton, Puntarenas, Costa Rica, from 1 to 4 June 2015, which will be hosted by the Costa Rica DGAC.

The ANI/WG/2 meeting will follow-up on the agreements achieved in ATM, AIM, CNS fields by the NACC/WG/4, *Port-of-Spain Declaration* (POS) targets, and the NAM/CAR Regional Performance-Based Air Navigation Implementation Plan (RPBANIP) priorities and objectives, analysing the implementation progress by each State/International Organization from the NAM/CAR Regions, works achieved by the ANI/WG Task Forces and identifying the benefits resulting from these implementations. Action Plans will be updated, as well as agreements will be defined as proposals to be approved by the Aviation Civil Directors. Finally, the progress report from this implementation will be analysed as part of the Regions monitoring and report to inform ICAO and the NAM/CAR Air Navigation Civil Directors.

All NAM/CAR States/Territories fields specialists from AIM, ATM and CNS, International Organizations, chairpersons, committee's rapporteurs and the regional work group members from Central America, Central Caribbean and the Eastern Caribbean Civil Aviation Technical Group (E/CAR/CATG) are expected to attend.

Likewise, it is important to take note that both chairpersons and work group rapporteurs, have to present their progress in the Meeting, as well as your Administration will be able to present any progress or benefit achieved from your Air Navigation Implementation National Plan aligned to the RPBANIP.

The working languages of the meeting will be English and Spanish, and simultaneous interpretation will be provided if sufficient participants of both languages provide timely registration.

The Provisional Agenda of the meeting is at **Attachment A** and the Provisional Schedule is presented at **Attachment B**. States wishing to submit proposals for the addition of items should do so by **1 April 2015**.

Papers received from international organizations will not be translated and will be issued only in the language submitted. The deadline to receive papers is 22 May 2015. The deadlines for submission of documentation for translation will be strictly enforced. You are encouraged to submit documentation in both meeting languages (i.e., English and Spanish).

Furthermore, in accordance with the 2013-2016 Activities Plan of the Regional Technical Cooperation Project for the Caribbean Region – *Implementation of Performance-Based Air Navigation Systems for the CAR Region (RLA/09/801)*, I am pleased to inform you that this event is offering one fellowship to each Project Member<sup>1</sup>.
