No Country Left Behind (NCLB) An ICAO Commitment

The NCLB campaign highlights ICAO's efforts to assist States in implementing ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs).



The NCLB effort also promotes ICAO's efforts to resolve identified Significant Safety Concerns (SSCs) through ICAO's safety oversight audits.

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North American, Central America and Caribbean Regional Office (NACC) Regional NCLB Strategy

Align with ICAO NCLB specific for the North American, Central America and Caribbean Regions and Regional priorities

Identified based on percentage of State Safety Oversight Effective Implementation (EI%), States in the NAM/CAR Regions were classified in three categories:








NACC Regional Effective Implementation (EI) % Status

47.6% of the States have an EI% below 70%

19% of the States have an El% between 70% and 80%

33.3% of the States have an El% over 80%







16.7% of the States in Central America have an EI % below 70%


50% of the States in the Central Caribbean have an El % below 70%


85.7% of the States in the Eastern Caribbean have an El % below 70%

Given Regional Reality and ICAO NCLB focus NACC developed NCLB Strategy to assist All States / Territories to achieve Desired outcomes Desired OUTCOME – within next 4 years 90% of NAM/CAR Regions will have sustainable Effective implementation (EI) of 80% to ensure safe, secure, and environmentally sound aviation systems

The Strategy was developed in March 2015, initiated first with Mexico and, as living process, continues to be refined

Communicate with Senior leaders (DGs/Ministers) for agreement on the strategy (RD accountable)



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Intelligence gathering with each State (NACC RO and CAA Teams accountable)





Coordinate and communicate data with DG and designated Teams (DG, RD and their technical staff)



Agree, at highest levels, tailored strategic plans and priorities for the next 2-3 years with each member States to meet their needs (DG, RD accountable)

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


