GLOBAL SAFETY INFORMATION PROJECT

- Introduction
 - Collection of safety information a key component of FAA & ICAO GASP
 - Initiatives to collect data termed Safety Data Collection & Processing Systems
 - Several issues involved involved with these systems

GLOBAL SAFETY INFORMATION PROJECT

- Safety Data Collection & Processing Systems
 - Duplication of effort
 - Lack of coordination between parallel programs
 - Protection of information is limited
 - Lack of programs to support open reporting
 - Lack of a consistent approach to the application of safety lessons

GLOBAL SAFETY INFORMATION PROJECT

- Project
 - Aim to collect information pertaining to the collection of safety data
 - Not collecting safety data
 - Information sought will include;
 - Mandatory and voluntary reporting processes
 - Safety databases used
 - How safety data is used
 - Protection of safety information
 - Sharing of safety information

GLOBAL SAFETY INFORMATION PROJECT

- Project
 - Two key regions involved;
 - Pan America
 - Asia Pacific
 - Will involve key stakeholders, including but not limited to;
 - Airlines
 - Aircraft operators
 - Airports
 - ANSPs
 - OEMs

GLOBAL SAFETY INFORMATION PROJECT

- Project
 - Supported by a communications strategy throughout the project
 - Regular reports will be produced
 - May lead to new initiatives to capture and analyse de-identified data from a macro perspective

GLOBAL SAFETY INFORMATION PROJECT

- Status
 - Project of up to three-year's duration
 - Communications plan being developed
 - Survey question sets being developed
 - Data capture information system to be developed
 - Survey to commence during Q2 2015

GO-AROUND PROJECT

- Research directed by Presage Group
- Joint project of FSF's International Aviation Committee and Business Aviation Committee
- Draft report released and presented at IASS
- Report to be re-drafted with recommendations, subject to peer review

SKYBRARY

- The Foundation and Eurocontrol have reached agreement to jointly manage SKYbrary
- Intent to grow SKYbrary as a global resource for aviation safety information
 - Currently very European centric
- A board to be established to oversee the management of Skybrary
 - Seeking to appoint someone from Latin America

STRATEGIC COMMUNICATIONS PLAN

- Developing with ALTA
- Aim is to enhance information flow to stakeholders and increase RASG-PA's visibility
- Possible methods include
 - Work with SKYbrary to post recommendations, etc.
 - Regular feature in FSF's *AeroSafety World*
 - Search engine optimization
 - More effective utilization of social media
 - Periodic newsletter
