Background – IWAF2015

✈ First-ever World Aviation Forum: Aviation Partnerships for Sustainable Development

✈ ICAO HQ, Montreal, Canada, 23-25 November 2015

✈ 800 participants

✈ ICAO Member States, international organizations, financial institutions and industry

✈ Supported NCLB campaign to assist States in implementing ICAO SARPs



IWAF2016 – Objectives

ICAO HQ, Montreal, Canada, 26 September 2016

To create a momentum, through the cooperation between States, the aviation community, international organizations and financial institutions, to:

- ✈ Identify and facilitate funding and financing required to accelerate the implementation of international civil aviation global standards and policies, plans and programmes in support of the NCLB initiative
- ✈ Ensure sufficient resources for sustainable aviation development using existing and new mechanisms by placing aviation in the heart of national development strategies with a view to overcoming the low-priority given to aviation in financing



IWAF2016 – Tentative Programme

- ✈ Drivers to Accelerate the “NCLB” Implementation
- ✈ Financing for Sustainable Growth of Aviation
 - ✈ Connectivity in Small Island Developing Countries (Caribbean)
- ✈ “NCLB” Round Table
- ✈ Dialogue on Aviation Development with the High-level Advisory Group on Sustainable Transport



IWAF2016 - Expected Outcomes

1. Higher number of States engaging in proposed/discussed funding and financing mechanisms to accelerate the NCLB implementation
2. Firm commitment of States to include and elevate the priority of the aviation sector into their national development plans to foster the sustainable development of States' air transport systems
3. Firm commitment of international organizations and financial institutions to funding and financing for sustainable aviation development
4. Better coordination and information sharing among donors and partners to improve efficiency and consistency in investing in aviation projects



Actions by the NACC/DCA/6 Meeting

1. States to:

- a. Identify their needs, as well as the common regional needs
- b. Include aviation in their national development plans and to position aviation as a strategic priority
- c. Propose projects (define solutions to the needs identified for resolving deficiencies, implementing NCLB, developing business cases, and finding potential donors and investors)
- d. Agree on preliminary regional work (regional Projects) that may be discussed in the NACC/DCA/6 Meeting and be presented in IWAF2016

2. States and all stakeholders to promote, support and participate in IWAF2016

3. Financial institutions to support ICAO's role as a facilitator of aviation development for mobilizing resources for infrastructure, capacity development and essential service needs
