#### ATTACHMENT A CAR/SAM Aviation Data and Analysis Seminar (Havana, Cuba 18 – 21 July 2017) GENERAL INFORMATION

### **1.** Place and Dates of the Event

The seminar will be held in Havana, Cuba from 18 to 21 July 2017 in Room Taganana of the *Hotel Nacional* of Cuba.

#### 2. Registration of Participants

The registration of participants will take place on Tuesday 18 July 2017 at 08:30 a.m.

#### 3. Opening Session

The opening session will take place on 20 July 2017 at 09:00 a.m.

#### 4. Languages and Documentation

This event will be held in English and Spanish. Documentation will be published on the following website https://www.icao.int/NACC/Pages/meetings.aspx?year=2017&cM=06&cY=2017 as available.

#### 5. Suggested Dress Code

Formal attire is recommended for the opening/closing and casual for the rest of the activities are recommended. Given the climate in Cuba the *guayabera* is considered a formal garment.

### 6. Local Time

The time in Cuba is normally set to -5 hours with respect to the Coordinated Universal time (UTC). At the time of the meeting, the daylight saving time applies (see NOTAM A0243/13), which means -4 hours with respect to UTC.

Commercial hours are Monday through Saturday from 10.00 AM to 6.00 PM. ATM are available 24/24 h.

### 7. Temperature

Climatological information for July in Havana is as follows: rainy with a monthly precipitations average of 118.6mm.

Monthly Average temperature: 27,6 °C 24 °C; Monthly average maximum temperature: 32.0 °C Monthly Minimum temperature: 24.2 °C

### 8. Electricity

The voltage in Cuba is 110 V. However, in recommended hotels electric power is 110-220 V.

## 9. Currency and Credit Cards

Currency is the Convertible Cuban Peso (CUC) which exchange rate is 1 USD = 1 CUC, and similar exchange rate with other currencies. When payment is in USD cash, a 10% duty is added. For undate information on exchange rates and accepted currencies please refer to<u>http://www.bc.gob.cu/espanol/tipo\_cambio\_metropolitano.asp</u>.

International credit cards such as Visa and Mastercard **that are not issued by United States banks** are normally accepted.

## 10. Travel Document

Participants can obtain entry visas through the Consulate of Cuba in their country. If necessary, please contact the meeting coordinators, submitting the needed information for the visa issuance.

### 11. Taxes, Gratuities, and Taxi Service

The recommended gratuity is 10% of the bill. Usually the tip is suggested at the end and it is optional for the establishment to include it or not.

Taxis provided by the Hotel are recommended for commutes in the city.

### 12. Security Recommendations

Security recommendations are the normal ones for every city, such as carrying only the needed cash, and not wearing jewellery or other valuables.

### 13. Communications

In addition to public phones (that allow urban, national and international calls), there are communication centres that offer telephone, fax and internet services. During the working sessions the meeting room provides Wi-Fi network. Suggested hotels offer Internet connection.
