## 7. Temperature

Temperature in Panama City during the month of October varies from 30°C to 22°C. The average humidity is of 85%.

#### 8. Transportation from/to the airport

It should be noted that the main streets and avenues in Panama are in a phase of expansion and maintenance; therefore, it is suggested to take the necessary measures and consider an additional time for transportation in order to avoid traffic jam at different hours.

There are authorized taxis services at Tocumen International Airport.

The rate of transportation – Taxis – to/from Tocumen International Airport and the zone of hotels is approximately US\$35.00 (additional person US\$12.00). The rate can be confirmed in the counters located at the exit from migrations office, at the airport. For safety reasons it is recommended to use the services of authorized Tourism taxis of the Tocumen Terminal, located in the following telephone numbers.
