- 2.2 The structure and working methods will have a distinctly different format than previous meetings. Many working papers have been replaced by presentations designed to not only provide information, but to solicit discussion and participation by States wishing to make interventions.
- 2.3 Furthermore, several discussion panel sections were included in the agenda, to be led by the Directors on relevant aviation matters.

Under this agenda item, several panel discussions on key topics such as safety and air navigation will be organized to allow the Meeting to review and share common implementation matters, concerns and best practices. The Directors of Civil Aviation are invited to lead panel discussions and propose actions for improving aviation in the NAM/CAR Regions. Panel discussions will cover but are not limited to:

- 5.2 Effectiveness of air navigation implementation mechanisms
- 5.3 Review of Project Proposals for State and government/non-government third parties funding
- 5.4 Emerging technologies and challenges

Moreover, the following topics will be discussed:

- 5.6 Improvements in Aviation Security/Facilitation (AVSEC/FAL) implementation
- 5.7 Collaboration on Aviation Training improvement/Next Generation of Aviation Professionals

Under this agenda Item, latest matters on Aviation Environment will be discussed including Market-based measures (MBM), States' Action Plans on CO2 Emissions Reduction Activities, State/region Implementation Status and Benefits Report and NCLB support/assistance approach for 2018.
