Following the Air Navigation Services improvement implementation within the regional plans and the NAM/CAR Regional Performance-Based Air Navigation Implementation Plan (RPBANIP) targets, and further to the Third NAM/CAR Air Navigation Implementation Working Group Meeting (ANI/WG/3) resolution, I wish to invite your Administration/Organization to participate in the Fifth North American, Central American and Caribbean Working Group Meeting (NACC/WG/5) to be convened at the premises of the Trinidad and Tobago Civil Aviation Authority (TTCA), Port of Spain, Trinidad and Tobago, from 22 to 26 May 2017, which will be hosted by the TTCAA of Trinidad and Tobago.

Only working papers received by this office by 21 April 2017, submitted by States/Territories, will be translated to ensure timely processing. Working papers received in this office after that date will have to be submitted in both languages, otherwise they will become information papers. Information papers will only be issued in the language submitted. Papers received from international organizations will not be translated and will be issued only in the language submitted. The deadline to receive papers is 8 May 2017. The deadlines for submission of documentation for translation will be strictly enforced. You are encouraged to submit documentation in both meeting languages (i.e., English and Spanish).

Furthermore, in accordance with the 2017 Activities Plan approved by the Steering Committee of the Regional Technical Cooperation Project for the Caribbean Region – *Multi-Regional Civil Aviation Assistance Programme (MCAAP) (RLA/09/801)*, I am pleased to inform that the Project is offering for this event one fellowship to each Project Member¹.

The fellowship includes Daily Subsistence Allowance (DSA) to cover lodging and per diem. Your Administration shall provide the candidate with the air ticket to/from Port of Spain, Trinidad and Tobago, and ensure that the candidate has the necessary travel documents, vaccinations, and visa prior to departure. The duly completed Fellowship Nomination Form must be received in this Regional Office by 1 May 2017.
