Prevention of Level Bust events: adoption of recommendations from Eurocontrol's Action Plan

- Reference document: Eurocontrol's Action Plan for the prevention of Level Busts
- Objective: Implement recommendations:
 - Update SOPs to reduce likelihood to level busts (e.g. reduce vertical speeds close to the end of climb);
 - Reduce flight deck workload by avoiding all activity not directly related to the safe conduct of the flight;
 - Ensure clear procedures for altimeter cross-checking and approaching level calls;
 - Always confirm the clearance if any doubt exists on the flight deck;
 - Always report the level cleared to when checking in on a new frequency while in the climb or descent.

- Strategy: At national level, gather data and review callsign designation rules.



DIP #3 BCAST DIP - Initial numbers

- Evaluation of scheduled flights table (15min initial)
- 4154 flights evaluated, 1317 identified conflicts
 - Format is ZZ1234
 - 100 anagram cases (1234 --- 4312)
 - 36 repetition cases (1333 – 6333)
- Time window variation increased number of repetition cases

Callsign conflicts – repetition cases



■ 30min ■ 25 min ■ 20 min ■ 15 min
