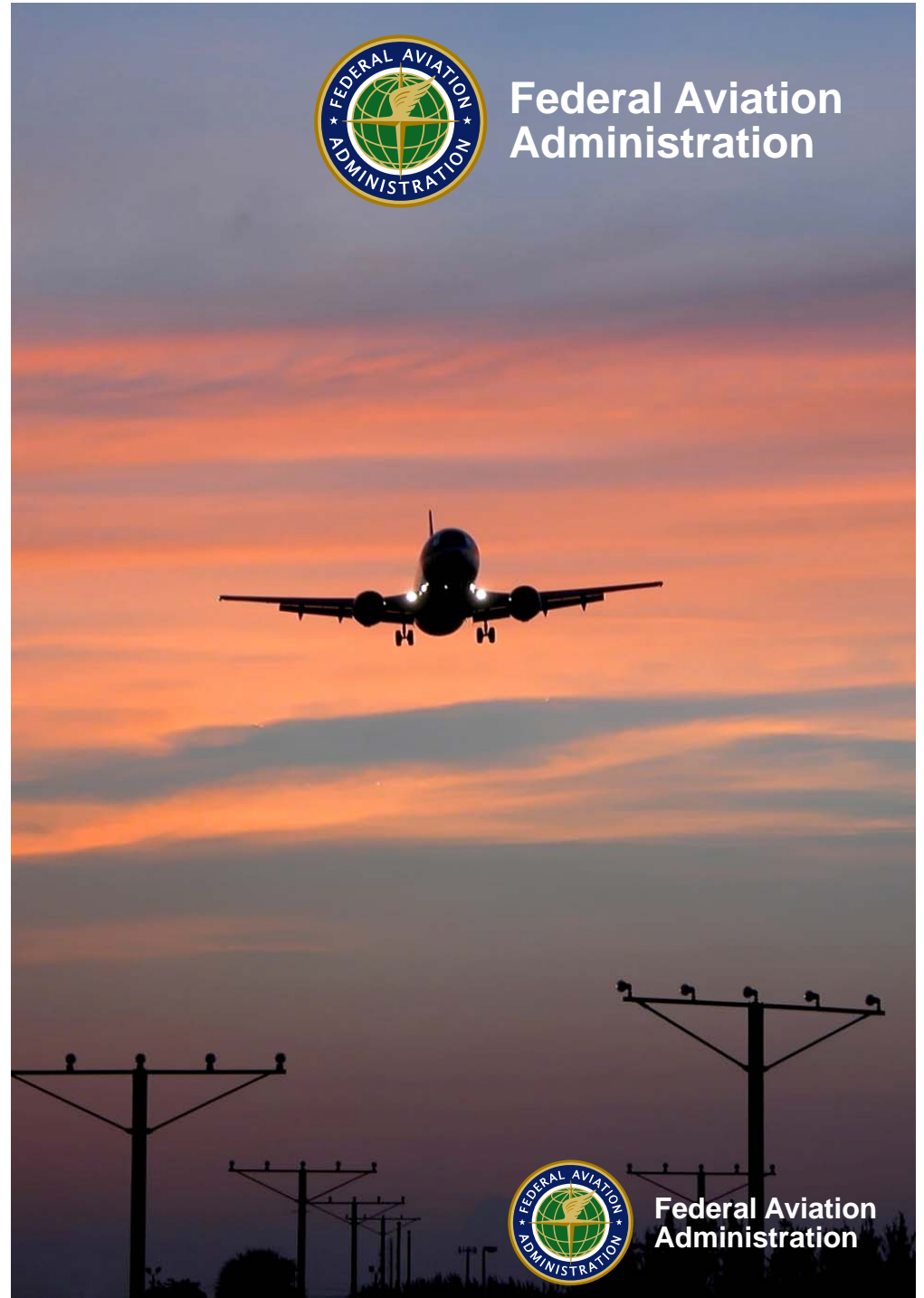

Implementation

- Florida Metroplex will implement November 8, 2018
- Jacksonville Center (ZJX), Miami Center (ZMA) and San Juan Center (ZSU) will utilize the new Q and Y route structure



Implementation

- Preferential route and automation changes will provide connectivity between current and new routes
- Preferential routes will be provided to industry, both international and domestic as well as all surrounding ANSP's prior to implementation
- Adjustment of playbooks and preferential routes
- Expect possible Traffic Management Initiatives during the implementation

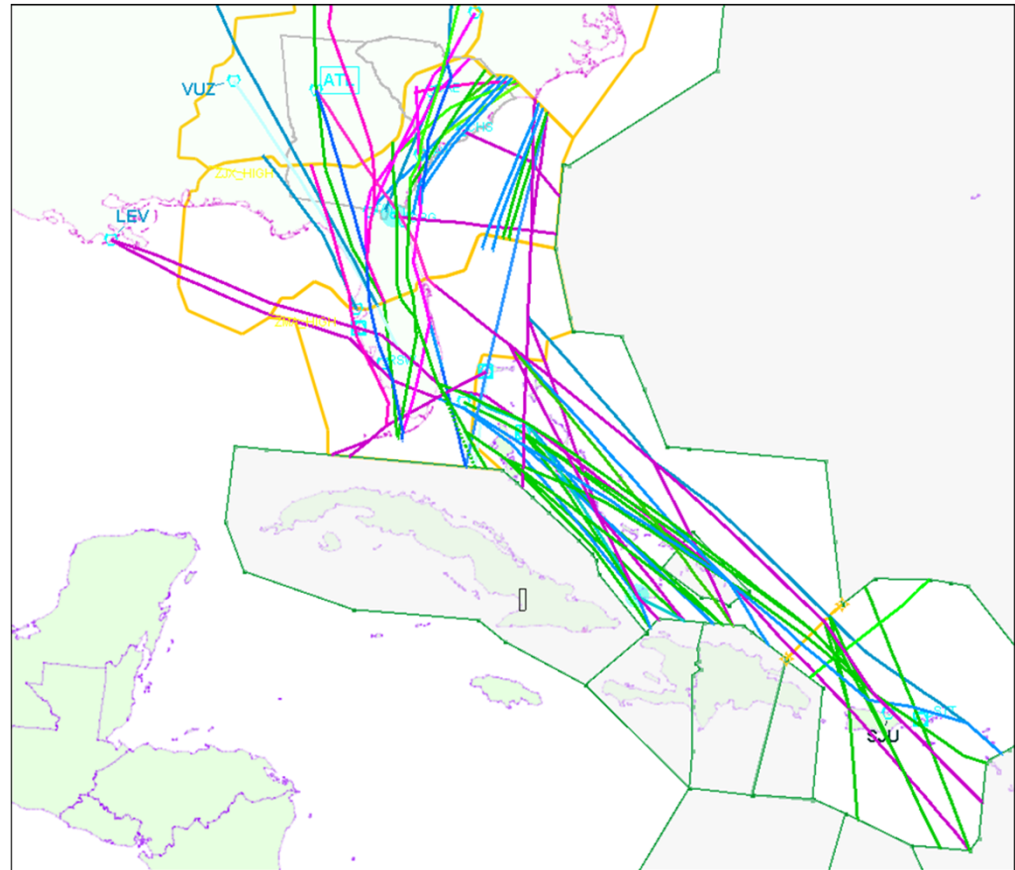

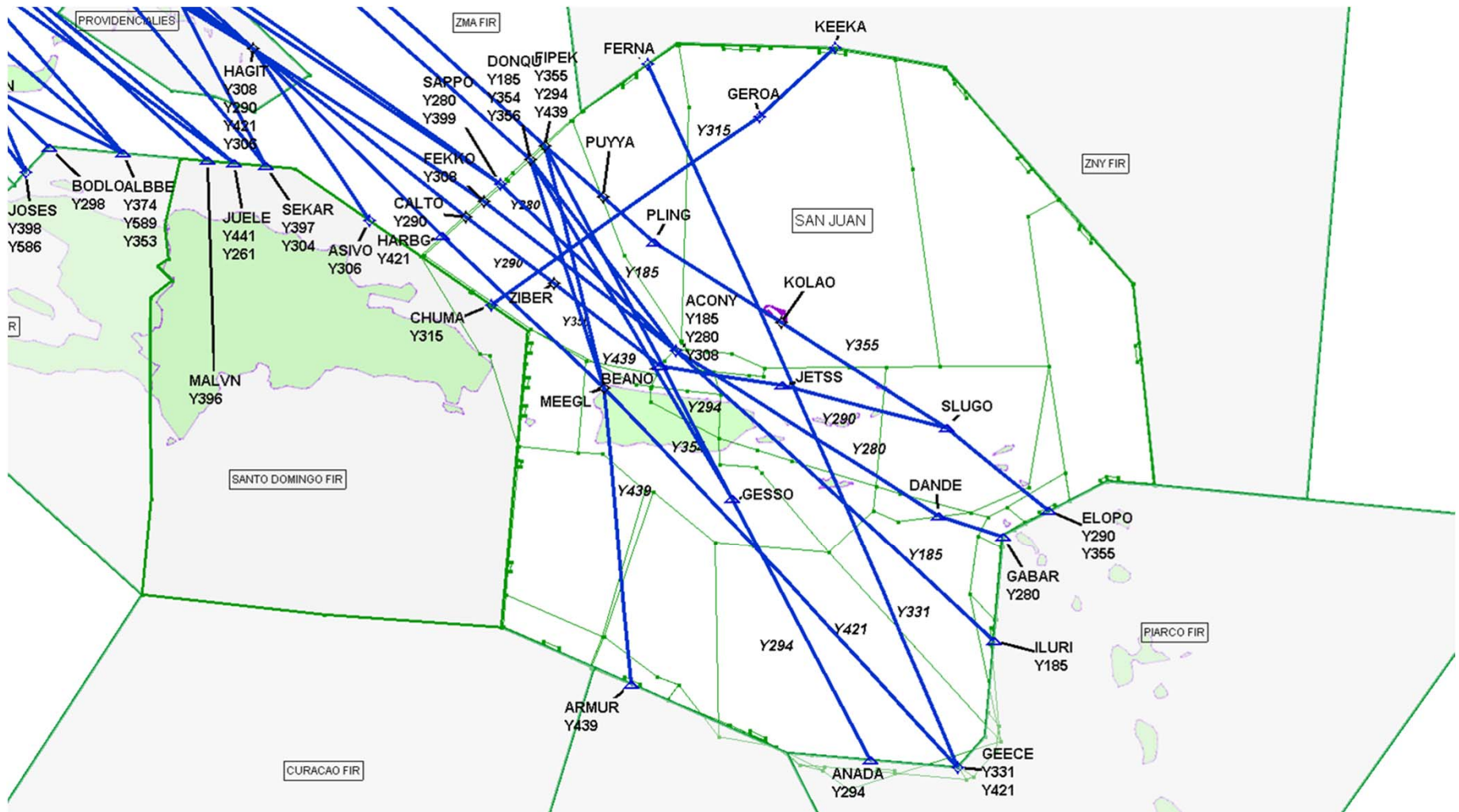

Florida Metroplex

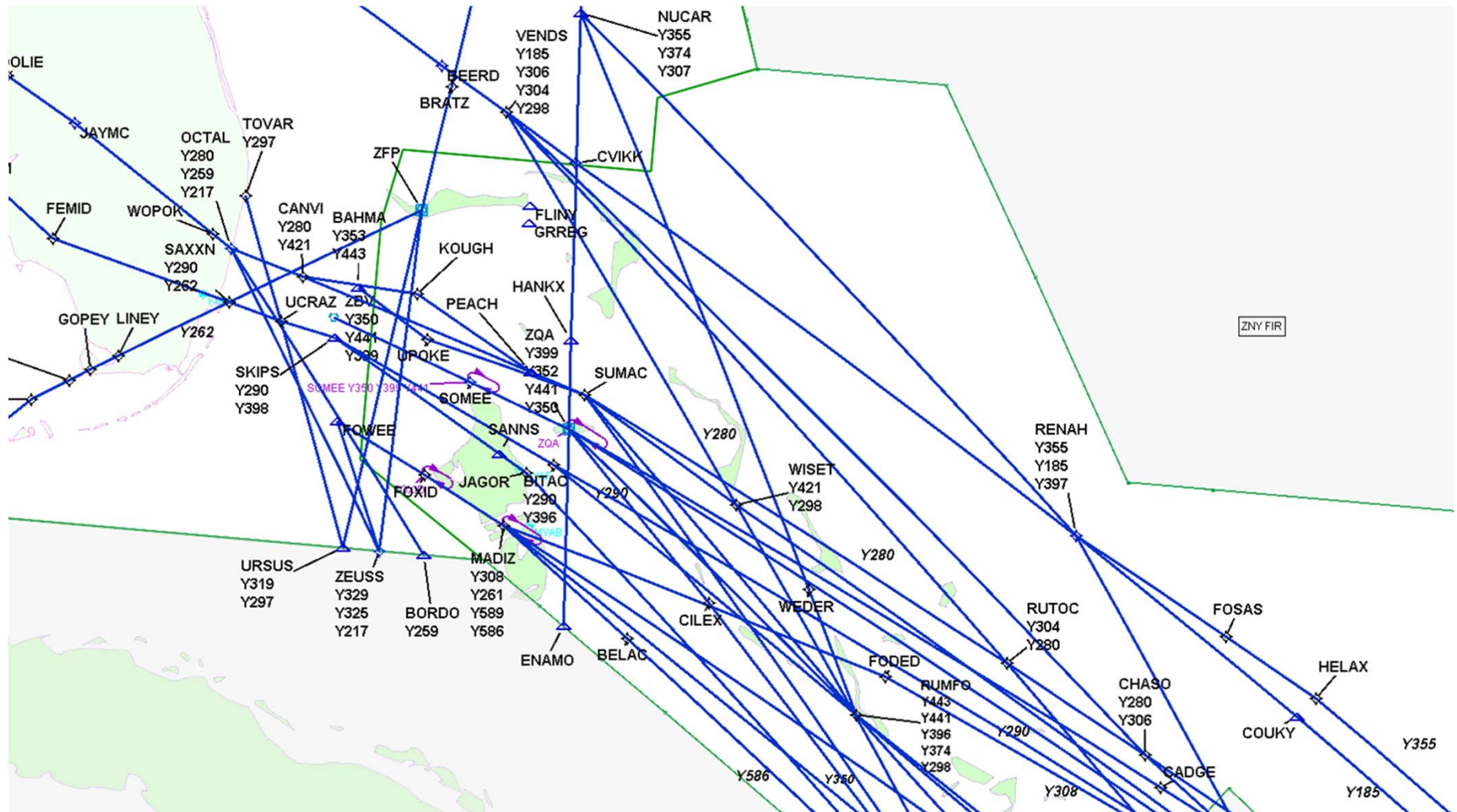
- 44 new Y routes

- 7 amended Q routes



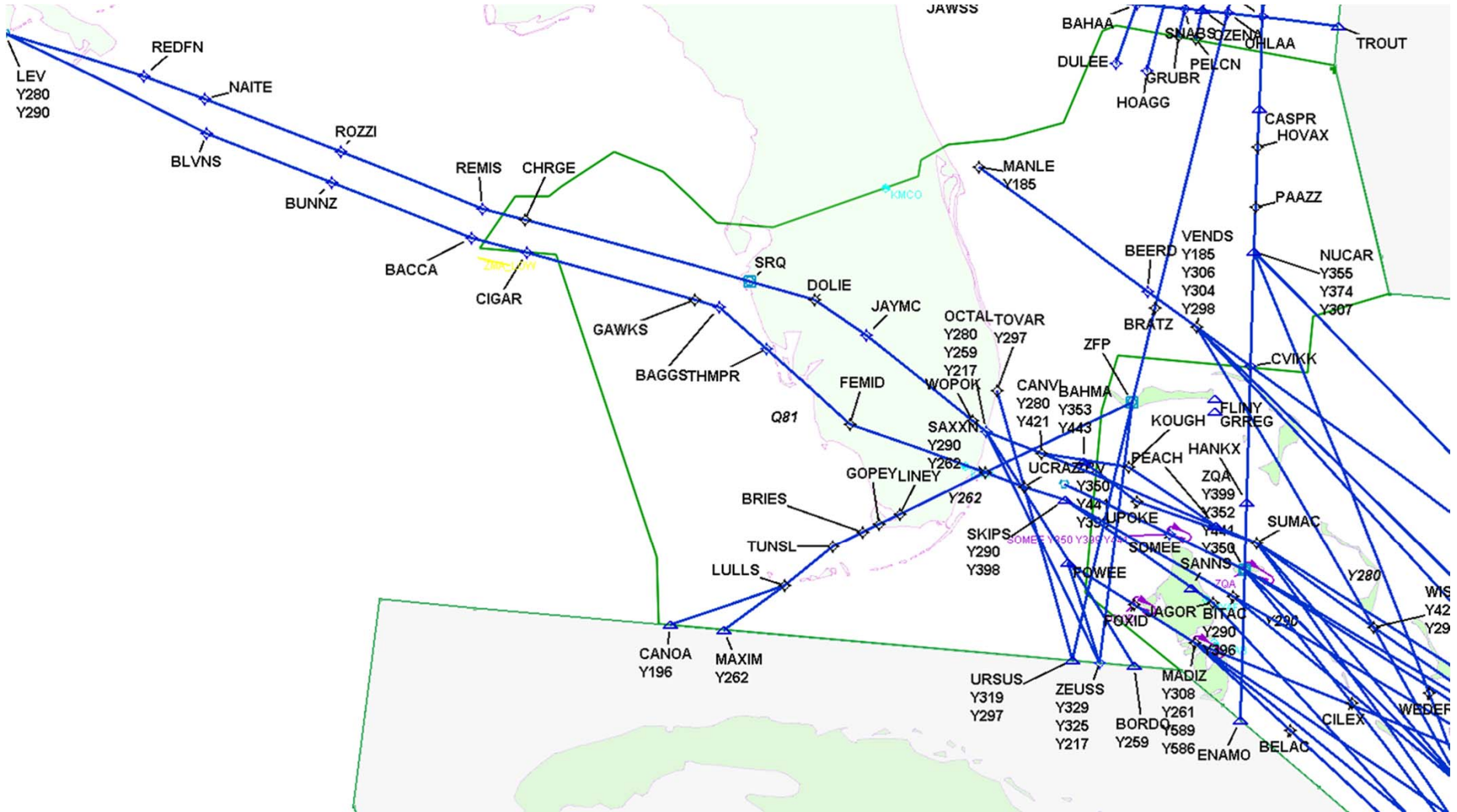
Florida Metroplex Q & Y Routes
