1. <u>Venue and Dates</u>

The Joint NAM/CAR Air Navigation Implementation Working Group (ANI/WG)/Air Traffic Flow Management (ATFM) Implementation Task Force Meeting (ATFM/TF)/CANSO Air Traffic Flow Management Data Exchange Network for the Americas (CADENA) Regional Implementation Group Meeting will take place in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, at the Air Navigation Services Headquarters of the Dominican Republic Civil Aviation Institute, from 22 to 24 January 2019:

3. <u>Participants Registration</u>

Registration will take place on 22 January 2019 from 08:30 to 09:00 a.m.

4. Languages and Documentation

The working language of the meeting will be English.

5. <u>Suggested Outfit</u>

Business casual outfit is suggested for the opening day and casual for the rest of the activities.

6. <u>Local Time</u>

The time in Dominican Republic is set to -4 hours with respect to the Coordinated Universal time (UTC)

7. <u>Temperature</u>

During the month of January, Santo Domingo averages a daily temperature between 22 to 28 degrees Celsius. The minimum temperature usually falls between 25 to 26 °C. The hurricane season is June 1 - November 30.

8. <u>Electricity</u>

The common voltage in Dominican Republic is 120 V. Frequency is 60 Hz. Electrical outlet plugs are types A / B (mainly used in the USA, Canada, Mexico, etc.).

9. <u>Currency and Credit cards</u>

Dominican Republic currency is the Dominican Peso (DOP), whose exchange rate is 1 USD = 49.5 DOP. It is recommended to change money only in established exchange posts and commercial banks, avoiding street and informal changers.

The international credit cards such as Visa, Master Card, and American Express are typically accepted in hotels, retail stores, and restaurants.

10. <u>Travel Document</u>

Participants must find out if they are required visa to enter the Dominican Republic territory. If required, they can obtain visa in the Dominican Republic Consulate of their respective countries. 11. <u>Safety Recommendations</u>

The safety recommendations are the normal ones for every city, such as carrying only the needed cash, and do not wear jewelry or other valuables. Extra precautions must be taken with cellphones and cameras.

Request transportation from authorized taxi services, the hotel taxi service and/or other international available transportation services (like UBER).
