








El Averages, All Regions

- ★ At NACC Region, 12 of 22 States (54%) were above 65% Effective Implementation of Critical Elements
- ★ 5 States scheduled for audits in 2019: Barbados, Costa Rica, Cuba (completed), Grenada (completed), Nicaragua
- **★** Currently NACC USAP EI (69.67%) is below the Global Average (72.58%)
- ★ Less effectively implemented areas, based on CEs: By 2020: CE-5, CE-6, CE-7, CE-8














Annex 17 Averages, All Regions

- ★ CMA data only (14 States), Annex 17 Functional Areas not captured in Cycle II
- ★ Results generally higher
- ★ Easier to identify areas for assistance
- ★ 9 of 14 NAM/CAR States (64%) audited under USAP-CMA were above 65% in Annex 17 Functional Areas.
- **★** Currently NACC A17 compliance (74.51%) is below the Global Average (79.32%)

Legislation: SARPs 3.1.1, 3.4.7

Training: SARPs 3.1.8, 3.4.3, 3.4.7

Quality Control: SARPs 3.4.5, 3.5.6, 3.4.7

NACC Assistance Proposal to Improve compliance

(Based on the above slide of USAP results)

- ★ Target Assistance missions to E/CAR and C/CAR States
- ★ ICAO Training assistance:
 - State to assess effectiveness of their participants to the Training provided
 - Training of National Inspectors to enhance CE-7 Quality Control and reinforce CE-5 Technical Guidance
- **★** Assistance and guidance on **CE-6 Certification and Approval Obligations** (second lowest)
- ★ Assess with AVSEC Authorities CE-8 Implementation of AVSEC measures and resolution of security concerns
- ★ States to complete and follow-up SAP Action Plans
- ★ Need to enhance Regional Organization to support States: CASSOS
- ★ Champion States are invited to support other States

Priority Outcome 1: Enhance Risk Awareness and Assessment

- ★ Promote risk awareness: Risk Context Statement Pamphlet, Risk Management Workshops
- ★ Test Point of Contact Network (annual requirement)

NAM/CAR Status: 11 of 22 States (50%) with completed risk assessment

12 of 22 States (54%) timely answered the PoC Network Test

2019/2020 NACC Office Assistance Plan actions

- Conduction of 2019 and 2020 PoC Network Test (completed for 2019!)
- Annually: 2 risk assessments at two voluntary States (English and Spanish) (pending)
- Workshop on Risk Assessment (pending)

Priority Outcome 2: Develop Security Culture and Human Capability

- ★ Widely distribute Toolkit on Enhancing Security Culture (2019)
- ★ Conduct Security Culture workshops in 2020
- ★ ICAO ISD-SEC and Working Group on Training to develop training material on new and emerging threats
- ★ Conduct Regional Training Needs analysis
- ★ Promote training cooperation (e.g. ASTCs)

2019/2020 NACC Office Assistance Plan actions

- Security Culture workshop scheduled in 2020 (pending)
- Annually one ICAO sponsored activity scheduled in each ASTC (completed for 2019!)
- Continue cybersecurity awareness through workshops and seminars (ICAO HQ in charge)

Priority Outcome 3: Improve Tech Resources and Foster Innovation

Primarily action for Working Groups, States and Industry

- ★ Outreach activities for effective tech use: improved resolution of security concerns (WGIAS)
- ★ Promote use of AVSECPaedia and attendance at AVSEC2019 (prelude to 40th Assembly in September)

Priority Outcome 5: Increase Regional Cooperation and Support

- ★ Enhance peer-to-peer assistance and support
- ★ Identify/mobilize funds for assistance
- ★ Assess root causes and analyze assistance needs based on risk
- ★ Expand to include collaboration from other Regions (e.g. UK → St Kitts and Nevis)

By 2020 establishment of a database for effective tracking of AVSEC assistance activities from international organizations (i.e. OAS-CICTE), States (i.e. TSA international activities) and industry (i.e. IATA IOSA audits)
