The Project Evaluation Commission (PEC)

Responsibilities:

annually assess and propose new activities for the **Project**;

proposing updates and amendments to the RLA09801 **MCAAP Project** PRODOC; and

identifying and monitoring methods for continuous improvement of the Project.



Third PEC Meeting

★ Main discussions:

- ★ need to update the Project Procedural Handbook
- ★ extension of the Project beyond 2020
- ★ role of the PEC and members focal points



- ★ work plan approval process and other procedures
- ★ changes of the rules related to the fellowships, and
- ★ potential of the Project for other uses



- ★ Second Edition of the MCAAP Procedural Handbook
 - ★ Main modifications proposed by PEC encompass:
 - ★provision for a periodically review of the composition of the PEC
 - ★strengthening of the role of members Focal Points
 - ★new work plan approval process, and
 - ★improvement of the Fast Track Procedure
 - ★adjustments in the process of granting fellowships





- **★**Project Evaluation Commission Composition:
 - ★Shall be approved by PSC every 2 years (allowing changes in the composition)
 - ★New proposed composition (until 2021):
 - ★Bahamas, Canada, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Mexico, United States, the ICAO NACC Regional Office and the ICAO Technical Cooperation Bureau



















★Ratification and Responsibilities of **Focal Points**

★PEC recommends PSC to approve:

- ★the role, activities and responsibilities of MCAAP Focal Points as mentioned in the MCAAP Procedural Handbook
- ★ focal points meet once a year one day before the PEC annual Meeting to provide input and guidance to the PEC






MCAAP Work Plan Approval Process

Proposals due to the **Project** Coordinator - 150 days before PSC













routine without budgetary impact:

- processed through electronic mail
- the lack of response will be presumed as "no objection"

budgetary or procedural impact:

- processed through the official channels of communication
- decided by PEC



★MCAAP Fellowships and Missions:

- ★ Fellowships for PEC and/or Focal Points missions should not be discounted from the quota of the States
- ★Greater flexibility in the use of fellowships (within their budgetary limits regarding each member)
- ★ Nomination forms shall be sent by the Focal Point at least 45 calendar days prior to the commencement of the event





- ★MCAAP Fellowships and Missions:
 - ★One single fellowship per event included in the annual work plan approved by the PSC
 - ★The total number of fellowships shall be equal for each member State/Organization





- ★ Extension of Project RLA09801 MCAAP
 - ★The Project will reach its end by July 2020
 - ★ The Project has proven to be an efficient tool to facilitate implementation
 - ★ It represents a means of providing training, technical assistance and fellowships to enable the participation of States in ICAO events





★Extension of Project RLA09801 MCAAP

★the PEC agreed on recommending the extension of Project RLA09801 MCAAP

- ★that shall be signed by the members before 31 July 2020
- ★requires a previous preparation of the Revision D of the PRODOC



★PEC to approve the 2020 Work Plan and the Draft Revision D of PRODOC in an extraordinary 4th PEC Meeting on November



- ★the new work plan approval process won't be applicable for 2020
- ★ the 40th Session of the Assembly will certainly have a direct impact on the activities and directions of the Project
- ★if approved, the extension of the Project will require a timely revision of the PRODOC



★Regional Procurement Activities



- ★ the Project be used to conduct regional procurement of equipment and services that are of interest to several MCAAP member States/Organizations
- ★ the funding for this procurement will be separated from the annual contribution
