Further to the Seventeenth Meeting of the GREPECAS Scrutiny Working Group (GTE/17), held in Lima, Peru, from 30 October to 3 November 2017, where Conclusion GTE/17/3 – *TRAINING FOR FOCAL POINTS* was agreed, I wish to invite your Administration/Organization to participate in the Training and Updating Workshop for Large Height Deviations (LHDs) Focal Points of the CAR/SAM Regions (CAR/SAM/LHD), to be convened at the ICAO South American (SAM) Regional Office premises in Lima, Peru, from 11 to 15 March 2019.

The working languages of the workshop will be English and Spanish, and simultaneous interpretation will be provided if sufficient participants of both languages provide timely registration.

Training and updating Workshop for LHD Focal Points of CAR/SAM Regions	 During the GTE/17 meeting in 2017, the Scrutiny Group agreed on the need of carrying out a training programme for the Points of Contact (PoCs) of the CAR/SAM Flight Information Regions (FIRs) to ensure a correct completion of CARSAMMA form F0 in which the Large Height Deviations (LHD) events are reported for the corresponding analysis by the CARSAMMA. With the aim of improving levels of reporting and analysis of the events, the Meeting agreed on the need to schedule a training process through CARSAMMA for LHD focal points of the CAR/SAM Regions, taking into account that there was new staff in these activities that had not yet received training, and that it would also serve as refresher training for the other focal points. During the meeting the following conclusion was adopted: CONCLUSION GTE/17/3 TRAINING FOR FOCAL POINTS That, taking into account the need to schedule training activities through CARSAMMA for LHD focal points of the CAR/SAM Regions, the Secretariat request the support of GREPECAS for the conduction of these activities in 2018. To follow up conclusion GTE/17/3 during the last GREPECAS meeting a working paper related to this matter was presented with the aim of preparing a workshop to train and update CAR/SAM focal points on the method of reporting and analyzing the LHD in the Reduced Vertical Separation Minimum (RVSM) airspace.	
Objective of the event	To train and update LHD Focal Points of the CAR/SAM Regions on the process of reporting and analyzing LHD in RVSM airspace.	
Status of the Region	Although the safety level in the RVSM airspace in the CAR/SAM regions is kept within acceptable limits, opportunities for improvement in safety and operational efficiency can be observed. The work of the focal points is essential to obtain these identified improvements, therefore the necessity of strengthening their competences by means of a workshop to update and reinforce the knowledge in the identification, analysis and implementation of related measures with the LHD, is key.
