**Team (RST) Implementation Workshop** San José, Costa Rica, 21 to 25 October 2019

Sir/Madam.

I am pleased to inform you that this ICAO NACC Regional Office has scheduled a Workshop on Safety Assessments and Implementation of Runway Safety Team (RST) Workshop. The events will be hosted by COCESNA in San Jose, Costa Rica from 21 to 25 October 2019.

The Workshop comprises two parts due to the subjects to be addressed. The first two days (21-22 October) the workshop will be focused on Safety Assessments. A safety assessment is a process to address the impact of a safety concern, including a change or deviation, on the safety of operations at the aerodrome and takes into consideration the aerodrome's capacity and the efficiency of operations, as necessary.

The Implementation of Runways Safety Teams (23-25 October) will deal with issues that have been addressed jointly in recent years with international organizations such as Airports Council International (ACI) through the edition of the guidance material on best practices and through the ICAO runway safety programme and a series of related events. The topics to be covered are: Runway Incursions (RIs), Runway Excursions (REs), and confusion in general, damage caused by Foreign Objects Damage (FOD), and wildlife management that have gained great importance for the runway safety operational aspects.

For RST implementation, it is very important to break down the barriers between the various operational organizations at the airport. Every time that these organizations come together as partners involved in the operational safety of the airport, it is easier to create situational awareness of the safety issues identified at the airport and to propose solutions by mutual agreement.

The workshop on Safety Assessments and Implementation of RST will be conducted by ICAO/FAA and ACI. Practical exercises will be delivered to participants, technical guidance will be provided and the terms of reference for establishing RST will be assessed.
