Sir/Madam,

Technology and cyber-systems have become essential to modern society being a component of many activities that have become dependent on information technology. Along with the benefit of the cyber technologies, insecurities arise, affecting all systems and infrastructures. Cyber threats and cyber-attacks have a transnational component and effect, as worldwide systems are interconnected. Furthermore, their complexity has implications for various actors at national, regional and international levels. As such from the ICAO Assembly Resolution A40/10 *Addressing Cybersecurity in Civil Aviation*, by which ICAO looks to develop actions to support States and industry in the adoption of the Cybersecurity Strategy; and continue to ensure that cybersecurity matters are considered and coordinated in a crosscutting manner through the appropriate mechanisms in the spirit of the Strategy.

ICAO continues producing Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPS) and guidance material to support States in their need and new challenges. Cybersecurity is a new challenger that must cover all air navigation services and security and facilitation activities, all aviation system.

ICAO in cooperation with the Civil Air Navigation Services Organization (CANSO) and AIRBUS will provide a series of events addressed to States and Air navigation services providers (ANSP), executive managers, focal points responsible for the Security Management System (SeMS), Information on security of the organization, Air traffic management/Communications, Navigation and Surveillance (ATM/CNS) responsible for ATM database configuration and other air navigation systems (ANS) responsible and anyone who is responsible in protecting the overall aviation security of the State or ANSP.

First session “Introduction to Cybersecurity” covers the Cybersecurity Strategy, information to understand the threats and risks associated with a cyber-attack and examples of a security breach within our industry. A draft agenda can be found in **Attachment A**.

The working languages of Webinar will be English and Spanish, and simultaneous interpretation will be provided (English-Spanish and Spanish-English).

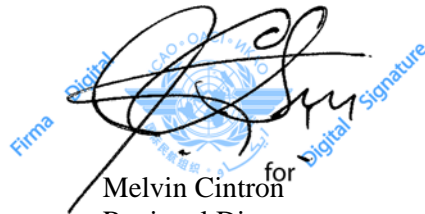
