Following up the last edition of the CAR/SAM Planning and Implementation Regional Group (GREPECAS) Procedural Handbook, under the Collaborative Arrangement with Regional Associations and Committees, GREPECAS has coordinated the arrangements to support regional implementation matters on air navigation for States support and benefit. Under these arrangements the Latin American and Caribbean Association of Airfield Pavements (ALACPA) and CAR/SAM Regional Bird/Wildlife Hazard Prevention Committee (CARSAMPAF) have confirmed their support to GREPECAS. In this regard, I wish to invite your Administration/Organization to participate in the Eighteenth CAR/SAM Regional Bird/Wildlife Hazard Prevention Committee Meeting and Conference (CARSAMPAF/18) to be held on virtual mode, in sessions from 14:00 to 17:30 hours (Mexico local time) (18:00 to 21:30 UTC) from 28 to 29 October 2020.

This event is aimed particularly for personnel responsible for the strike hazard evaluation with wildlife elements in aerodromes or its surroundings, as well as the establishment of national measures and the continuous assessment that forms part of a National Committee.
