Sir/Madam.

Taking into consideration the recurrent need to implement changes in the Air Traffic Services (ATS) route system of the CAR Region, and in order to achieve operational improvements for both operators and ATS providers, the NAM/CAR Air Navigation Implementation Working Group Performance-Based Navigation Concept Task Force (PBN TF) developed a process for approval and implementation of proposals of optimization of the CAR Region airspace, which was presented to the Fifth NAM/CAR Air Navigation Implementation Working Group Meeting (ANI/WG/5), held from 27 to 31 May 2019 in Mexico City, Mexico.

This process took into account the required coordination timeframe for approval of the proposals and for a dynamic implementation, including adequate coordination with users and neighbouring regions. Due to the COVID-19 outbreak, it was not possible to hold a meeting of the PBN TF. Therefore, preliminary coordination teleconferences have been carried out with all States/Flight Information Regions (FIRs) of the CAR Region to move forward concerning the proposals for amendments to the CAR/SAM Air Navigation Plan Table of routes in 2021. Furthermore, an analysis of the requests from States for PBN routes through the region and bilateral/multilateral meetings have been carried out.

In order to continue with the process, I wish to invite the PBN Task Force to participate in the Optimization of the CAR Region Airspace Meeting (ANI/WG/PBN/TF/OPT), finalize the discussion and formalize the agreement with the proposals for airspace optimization of the Caribbean Region that will lead to the optimization of the CAR ATS routes structure expected to be implemented in 2021. The meeting will be convened from 20 to 23 October 2020, via Zoom from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm (CDT).
