Dear Sir/Madam,

The implementation of the automated protocols is a facility that keeps supporting safety and efficiency and above all the development in the region.

Continuing with this work is a priority for the region due to the important benefits that this implementation provides. In this regard, a Fourth NAM/CAR Air Traffic Services Inter-facility Data Communication (AIDC) and North American Interface Control Document (NAM/IDC) Implementation Follow-up meeting will be held. This event will be on-line from 9 to 11 March 2021, with a daily session from 9:00AM to 12:00PM (GMT-6).

The objective of the Meeting is to follow-up on previous AIDC meetings and on the activities agreed by the States for the national and regional implementation through:

- 1. Updating the implementation activities of the automated protocols in the CAR Region
- 2. Follow-up on the measures to optimize flight plans management and aeronautical information management to minimize errors in the Flight plans (FLP)
- 3. Introduction of Global Air Navigation Plan (GANP) tasks linked to light and flow information for a collaborative environment (FF-ICE)
- 4. Analysis of cybersecurity that is applied to databases of Air Traffic Management (ATM) systems
- 5. Alignment of the NAM/CAR Air Navigation Implementation Working Group (ANI/WG) AIDC Task Forcewith the programme of CAR/SAM Planning and Implementation Regional Group (GREPECAS)

The participant experts profile is very important to reach the regional automation goals considering that they will provide the recommendations needed to allow the effective operational implementation of both protocols.

In this sense, the participation of personnel responsible for the AIDC and NAM/ICD implementation projects of the different States is highly recommended. Furthermore, the participation of members of the ANI/WG AIDC Task Force is expected.

The industry is also invited to present subjects associated with the proposed agenda. Due to this new meeting mode, its contributions to the meeting will be coordinated.

The event will be bilingual (English-Spanish) and simultaneous interpretation services will be provided.

Working papers should be brief, action-oriented, and focused with a four-page limit excluding any appendices.

<u>Only</u> working papers <u>received</u> by this office by <u>25 February 2021</u>, submitted by States/Territories, will be translated to ensure timely processing, <u>after</u> that date, they will have to be submitted in both languages. Otherwise, they will become Information Papers. Working papers of the rest of the Agenda Items can be sent in **English** only. Information papers will only be issued in the language submitted. Papers received from international organizations will not be translated and will be issued only in the language submitted. The deadline to receive papers is <u>25 February 2021</u>. The deadlines for <u>submission of documentation will be strictly enforced</u>. You are encouraged to submit documentation in both meeting languages (i.e., English and Spanish).

All meeting documentation (working/information papers and/or presentations) will be placed in the Meetings Section of the following web page: <u>https://bit.ly/3qX0Lux</u> as it becomes available. Taking into consideration the availability of documentation in electronic format, no hard copies will be distributed during the event.
