 Customized implementation support, based on the specific need(s) of a State

- Standardized Training Packages
- iPacks
- Implementation Support Programme



Diversification of the Portfolio of Products and Services

- Newly developed products and services to support the technical assistance framework for Safety and Air Navigation
- Products are **aligned**, **integrated**, **cooperative**, **results-based** and **harmonized** and aim to provide Implementation Support as **One ICAO**
- Developed based on:
 - priority needs
 - avoiding duplication of efforts
 - optimizing allocation of resources





Standardized product: Implementation Support Programme (ISP)

Standardized & medium/longer-term support

Implementation Support Programme (ISP)



ISP is a standardized, multi-phased, longer term, thematic implementation support programme aimed at providing a comprehensive array of activities to facilitate the implementation of relevant ICAO provisions. A medium to large scale project in terms of size, scope, budget and personnel and will provide flexibility to adapt to varying States' needs with a menu of products, services & activities. First ISP under development for Enhancing Safety Oversight Capacity



Implementation Packages (iPacks)

- Established in 2020 to support COVID-19 recovery efforts
- An Implementation Package (iPack) is a bundle of support composed of the relevant:
 - Subject matter expertise
 - Guidance material
 - Standardized training
 - Tools (including data-driven applications)
 - Procurement Guidance (when applicable)
- **Duration:** Short intervention (3 to 6 months)





Scope and Outcome of an iPack

iPacks are intended to:

- Ensure State implementation activities are aligned with the most up-to-date ICAO provisions
- Ensure State implementation activities, although flexible, facilitate mutual acceptance by other States
- Facilitate access to harmonized, ready-to-use implementation support for ICAO Member States


