ISD-SEC Programme 1/4

Aviation security assistance and training at ICAO is supported on a global basis by the **Implementation Support and Development Section - Security (ISD-SEC),** in coordination with the Regional Offices and the Technical Cooperation Bureau.

ISD-SEC is also guided by the **Global Aviation Security Plan** (**GASeP**) adopted by the ICAO Council at its 212th Session in November 2017 to support global aviation security enhancement efforts.





ISD-SEC Programme 2/4

Pursuant to Assembly Resolutions A41-18, Consolidated statement on continuing ICAO policies related to aviation security, and Recalling Resolution A40-12 on the Declaration on Aviation Security – affirming global commitment to strengthening implementation, the ICAO Secretariat aims to implement targeted training and assistance to address identified aviation security deficiencies for those States in need and for those States who wish to build their capabilities to sustain effective implementation of Annex 17 – Aviation Security.

The importance of aviation security was also reaffirmed with the adoption of the **United Nations Security Council resolution (UNSCR) 2309** (2016) calling on ICAO to assist States in complying with international aviation security standards.




Despite the challenges from the COVID-19 pandemic, ISD-SEC continued to adapt its work programme, focusing on the virtualization of much of its aviation security training, alongside the roll out of **new and updated training material** and the **Aviation Security Implementation Package (AVSEC iPack)**.

In support of the ICAO Year of Security Culture (YOSC) 2021, there has also been a heavy focus on the provision of security culture training and assistance to maintain the security culture momentum.

























ICAO Training Achievements 2022

- 30 ICAO-sponsored AVSEC training activities via ASTCs
- 7 virtual-class and 23 in-person events
- Benefitting **427** AVSEC specialists from **90** Member States
- Annual Newsletters were issued for ICAO Certified Instructors
- 1 AVSEC PMC conducted benefitting 12 AVSEC specialists (2 PMCs in progress)

ICAO Assistance Achievements (as of 25 Nov)

- In total, **13** States globally are currently involved in an active AVSEC Improvement Plan (ASIP):
- iPack AVSEC Quality Control Oversight (iPack-AVSEC)
- iPack designed to guide State Authorities responsible for AVSEC and other relevant stakeholders in their efforts to maintain and strengthen surveillance measures during and after the pandemic
- **20** iPack-AVSEC deliveries done in 2021, **5** iPack-AVSEC deliveries in 2022 and additional **5** iPack-AVSEC deliveries in 2023
- Air Cargo and Mail Security Course (virtual) and Risk Management Workshop (virtual) through partnership with UNODC/WCO Container Control Programme (CCP): **6** beneficiary States
- Cooperation with UNOCT on the Programme on Threat Assessment Models for Aviation Security (TAM Programme): **3** beneficiary States
- For 2022, as of 25 Nov 2022, there were a total of 68 ICAO HQ-supported AVSEC assistance activities, benefitting 1052 AVSEC specialists from 85 Member States













ICAO Security Culture: Background (2)

- Amendment 18 to Annex 17 (applicable 18 Nov 2022). New Recommendation (3.4.7) — Each Contracting State should require entities involved with or responsible for the implementation of various aspects of the national civil aviation security programme to promote, develop and implement measures and mechanisms that contribute to establishing a strong and effective security culture
- 41st Session of the ICAO Assembly recognized the ongoing need to promote the enhancement of security awareness and a strong and effective security culture in aviation, by Member States, industry and other stakeholders
