

# AFI Plan Project Implementation – Aerodrome Certification

Dec 2017: Five out of 18 Intl Aerodromes certified in 18 Beneficiary States

# AFI Plan Project Implementation – State Safety

# **24 Beneficiary States**

- provide safety management training to Regulatory and Service provider staff involved in SSP/SMS implementation;
- assist States conduct SSP Gap Analysis and develop SSP implementation plans;
- assistance missions conducted in 11 out of 24 States (46%): Botswana,
  Cameroun, Cote d'Ivoire, Gambia, Kenya, Mali, Mauritania, Mauritius, Togo, Zambia and Zimbabwe;
- 2 additional States (Equ. Guinea & Rwanda) met 60% El eligibility criterion, hence need for review of project budget to accommodate newly qualified States.



# AFI Plan Project Implementation – SAR Organization

## **30 Beneficiary States**

**Objective:** establishment and provision of effective and operational SAR services

- Survey conducted followed by gap analysis on the status of SAR implementation;
- Technical Experts Team established, Templates and Sample SAR documentation developed and assistance missions conducted.

#### **Outcomes:**

- six States have developed and promulgated SAR Legislation;
- Five States have developed and promulgated SAR Regulations;
- Fifteen States have fully developed and approved national SAR plans
- Fifteen SAR Agreements between States are currently in force



# AFI Plan Project Implementation – ANSP Peer Review

#### **All AFI States**

**Objective:** establishment of regional framework of cooperation and peer review mechanism to improve air navigation operational performance in Africa

- ToRs of ANSP Peer Review Programme Coordination Team of Executives established;
- Programme Reference Manual, Cooperation Framework and a Roadmap for 2017-2018 developed and endorsed.
- Training conducted on Peer Review Programme Manual

#### **Next Steps:**

- conduct of pilot reviews;
- development and implementation of corrective action plans; and
- project evaluation.



AFI Plan Project Implementation - Establishment of Fundamentals of Safety Oversight (FSO)

**12 Beneficiary States**: Burundi, Central African Republic, Comoros, Djibouti, Eritrea, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Lesotho, Liberia, Sao Tome and Principe, Seychelles and Swaziland

#### **Objectives**

- establish a sound and sustainable aviation safety oversight system addressing Critical Elements 1 to 5 (Primary Legislations, Regulations, civil aviation system organization; Qualification of technical personnel; Guidance material, leading to:
  - Implementation of effective safety oversight through proper licensing / certification activities, surveillance and resolution of safety concerns; and
  - to enhance EI levels to over 60%
- The project document presented to the beneficiary States for their acceptance and commitment to implement the project's recommendations





#### AFI Plan Project Implementation —Establishment of Basic AIG System in AFI States

**Beneficiary States** : All AFI States

#### **Objectives:**

- assist States develop harmonized AIG legislation, regulations and associated procedures with respect to AIG.
- to enhance EI levels to over 60%
- Nigeria and Ethiopia have accepted to host two workshops to be conducted from 28 to 31 August 2018 in Legos and 3 to 6 September 2018 in Addis Ababa as part of the project.



#### Recommendation

#### To encourage:

- The AFI Plan Secretariat to continue to coordinate and monitor implementation of the six on-going AFI Plan projects for Aerodrome Certification, State Safety Programme (SSP) Implementation, Air Navigation Services Provider (ANSP) Peer Review, Search and Rescue (SAR); Fundamentals of Safety Oversight (FSO) and AIG;
- Development partners to continue providing support to African States through their implementation assistance activities aimed at improving aviation safety in the region;
