#### 1. Introduction

1.1 The Recommendations of the Special AFI RAN Meeting, Durban, South Africa 24-29 November 2008, Conclusions and Decisions of APIRG 16 Rubavu, Rwanda, 19-23 November 2007, as well as Conclusions/Decisions of the ATS/AIS/SAR/SG/10 meeting in Dakar 12-15 May 2009, which are directly relevant to the work of the PBN and the GNSS/I Task Forces were reviewed by the First Joint Meeting of the APIRG Performance Based Navigation and Global Navigation Satellite System Implementation Task Forces held in Nairobi, 8-10 September 2009. The meeting also reviewed Conclusions/Decisions of the past meetings of the two Task Forces.
