### **SUMMARY**

The publishing of AFTN addresses and contact telephone numbers for designated SPOC's in order to facilitate contact with such facilities.

#### 1. Introduction

1.1 The CAR/SAM and AFI Air Navigation Plans, both reflect the requirement, "States which have not already done so, should designate a SPOC which will receive alerts detected by the COPSAS – SARSAT system.

### 2. General

- 2.1 Although the Air Navigation Plans reflect units which have been designated as a SPOC for that particular FIR, AFTN addresses and telephone contact numbers are not supplied.
- 3. **Actions required:** States are invited,
- 3.1 To designated a SPOC in order to facilitate liaison between States, which may be enquired to supply SAR information
- 3.2 To publish contact details of such a designated SPOC and to supply the same detail to the MCC responsible for serving the region in which the SPOC is located.
- 3.3 To request ICAO to assist in establishing a common point of reference regarding the contact details of such SPOC's and to maintain the detail contained there in current.
