ICAO Aviation Training Activities Implemented Globally and in the AFI Region

(Presented by the ICAO Global Aviation Training Office)

SUMMARY

The Global Aviation Training (GAT) Office's third year of operation has encompassed the development and consolidation of major tools and methods in aviation training. This working paper summarizes ICAO's GAT activities implemented globally, as well as those undertaken in the AFI Region.

RELATED ICAO STRATEGIC OBJECTIVE(S): This working paper relates to all Strategic Objectives and Supporting Implementation Strategies.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Since its establishment on 1 January 2014, the GAT Office has been responsible for the planning, management, and coordination of ICAO aviation training activities to ensure the efficient, effective, and harmonized implementation of the ICAO Civil Aviation Training Policy. The GAT Office oversees the TRAINAIR PLUS Programme (TPP), Training Design and Development (TDD) activities, as well as Training Assessments and Consultancy (TAC).

2. GLOBAL AND REGIONAL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TRAINAIR PLUS PROGRAMME

2.1 TPP, ICAO's cooperative network of training centres, is implemented in 87 ICAO Member States. As of 1 October 2016, TPP membership is composed of 92 Civil Aviation Training Centres (CATCs), 8 of which joined in 2016. It includes 21 Regional Training Centres of Excellence (RTCEs), 31 Full Members, 37 Associate Members, and 3 Corporate Members. 2.2 In the AFI Region, 16 training organizations are recognized as TPP Members in the following categories: 5 RTCEs, 4 Full Members and 5 Associate Members. The list of TPP Members in the AFI Region is indicated in Appendix A. An additional 4 training organizations in the AFI Region are currently undergoing the assessment process to join TPP.

2.3 In line with TPP's objective to build internal capacities of training organizations and reduce costs of course development and delivery, ICAO's instructor and course validator qualification processes and requirements have been updated and communicated to Members of the network. Customized and user-friendly online applications have been developed to facilitate the qualification process and monitor the currency of these experts.

3.0 GLOBAL AND REGIONAL IMPLEMENTATION OF TRAINING DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT (TDD) ACTIVITIES

3.1 The implementation of competency-based training courses supports human resources capacity-building of Member States in all ICAO Strategic Objectives. In 2015, ICAO launched a training course development plan broadening the categories of ICAO-harmonized training packages, which now includes ICAO Training Packages (ITPs), Standardized Training Packages (STPs), Compliant Training Package (CTPs), and Partnership Training Packages (PTPs).

3.2 As of 1 October 2016, 128 training courses have been made available to support Member States and the aviation industry in their capacity-building for training activities. Additionally, a total of 67 courses are currently being developed. The table below indicates a breakdown of developed courses per category

3.3 Training organizations in the AFI Region developed a total of 12 ICAO-harmonized training while an additional 14 are under development. Appendix B includes a table indicating all courses developed by TPP Members in the AFI Region.

3.4 In 2016, the Government Safety Inspector (GSI) and the European Co-ordination Centre for Aviation Incident Reporting System (ECCAIRS) Technical and End User Training Courses were integrated into the TRAINAIR PLUS Electronic Management System (TPeMS) and made available to the network. Other courses were also developed, including Control of the Authenticity and Validity of Travel Documents at Airport Borders – Level 1 and Safety Management Training Programme (SMTP). Furthermore, to support the implementation of safety management systems in Member States, the GAT Office, in collaboration with Regional Offices and the Air Navigation Bureau, is training Regional Officers to become SMTP-qualified instructors (2 sessions will be held in Nairobi, Kenya, and in Dakar, Senegal, in December 2016).

4.0 TRAINING ASSESSMENTS AND CONSULTANCY

4.1 The GAT Office conducts assessments of training organizations to analyse their capability to become a TPP Member. Assessments provide a clear and independent view of a training organization's operations and highlights critical areas requiring improvements. Assessments of training organizations outside of TPP are also being conducted upon request by States, under the consultancy services. The GAT Office conducted 162 assessments, which identified 31 non-conformities under Category 1 (recommendations) and 1 188 under Category 2 (observations) to be corrected by Members.

4.2 In 2016, 5 training centres in AFI Region have completed their assessment process while an additional 2 training centres are projected to finalize their assessments before year end 2016.

5. TRAINING EVENTS

5.1 The annual Aviation Training and TRAINAIR PLUS Global Symposium was held in Seoul, Republic of Korea, from 11 to 13 May 2016, and attracted 760 participants from 70 States and international organizations. Moreover, 2 Course Developers and Instructors Standardization meetings are being held before the end of 2016 in Nairobi, Kenya, and in Bogotá, Colombia. Other upcoming global and regional training events, including the next Aviation Training and TRAINAIR PLUS Global Symposium in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, will be convened in 2017.

6. NEW TRAINING TOOLS AND GUIDANCE MATERIAL SUPPORTING CAPACITY BUILDING

6.1 The GAT Office is making available the following new tools in the next triennium to support Member States in their capacity-building initiatives:

a) **Online job task catalogue,** comprising standardized job descriptions and competencies for job positions identified during the development of STPs, in accordance with ICAO's *Training Development Guide, Competency-based Training Methodology* (Doc 9941);

b) **Training Instructors Guide (TIG)** to support aviation professionals in delivering ICAOharmonized training packages and other competency-based training developed by TPP Members.;

c) **Instructional Systems Design (ISD) web-based tool** to guide and support the implementation of the TPP methodology for course development;

d) **Training Needs Assessment tool** to support Member States in identifying and prioritizing specific training needs. A prototype is under development and a pilot project is underway;

e) **Roadmap,** providing guidelines to support States in the implementation of aviation training and capacity-building activities;

f) **Post-Training Evaluation (PTE) methodology Post-Training Evaluation (PTE) methodology** to evaluate the impact of training on trainees and on the organization they work for, measured through a series of surveys. A methodology to evaluate training effectiveness for level 1 (Reaction) and level 2 (Learning) was established. Survey results from this methodology are being used for future course improvements. The assessment of level 3 (Behaviour) is currently being applied to selected ICAO training courses and will gradually be implemented for all ICAO-harmonized courses starting from 2017; and g) **Aviation Training and Education Directory, (ATED)**, providing user-friendly interface and search mechanism for courses, training centres, and tertiary educational providers.
