SUMMARY

This working paper reviews the interconnectivity between AFISNET ,NAFISAT and SADC11 VSAT networks

1. Introduction:

1.1 NAFISAT and SADC 11 networks became operational in November 2008. The interfacing centre are: Niamey –Tripoli, N^Djamena – Tripoli, N^Djamena – Khartoum, Khartoum –Brazzaville, Brazzaville – Nairobi, Brazzaville –Luanda, Luanda –Dakar ,Luanda - Abidjan and Accra- Luanda.

2. Discussion

2.1 All the circuits have been implemented except Accra –Luanda which is in the process of implementation. Attachment A is the diagram showing all the interconnecting Circuits. Attachment B is the availability chart for Nairobi showing the connection Nairobi – Brazzaville. States are urged to submit the availability data of the interfacing circuits; this will help in the analyses of the missing flight plans.

3. Action to be taken by the Meeting:

- a) The meeting to take note of the above information;
- b) Center should endeavor to submit the monthly AFTN availability statistics to the regional office; and
- c) Ghana to implement the circuit Accra Luanda as soon as possible





Diagram 2: AFTN Circuits
