#### 1. Introduction

The First Meeting of the AFI ATS Message Handling System Implementation Task Force (AFI AMHS /I/ TF/1) established by APIRG/17 (Ouagadougou, Burkina Faso, July 2010), was held in Nairobi, Kenya from 19 to 20 May 2011. The meeting deliberate on its agenda items and formulated five (05) conclusions and four (04) decisions.

## 2. Discussion

The secretariat developed and published the report on the meeting on the Webpages of ICAO WACAF and ESAF Regional offices. These conclusion and decisions were endorsed by the fourth meeting of APIRG Communication Navigation and Surveillance Sub Group (CNS/SG/4) held from 25 to 29 July 2011 in Dakar, Senegal and submitted to the approval of APIRG 18 meeting held in Kampala Uganda from 27 to 29 March 2012.

Since this AFI AMHS Implementation Task force first meeting, follow up actions have been undertaken in coordination with states in order to ensure the harmonization of the implementation.

However the Secretariat often encountered lack of feedback on the status of implementation of these conclusions and decisions. The information gathered on the status of implementation is summarized up in Appendix to this Working Paper.
