1. Introduction

The First Meeting of the AFI ATS Message Handling System Implementation Task Force (AFI AMHS /I/ TF/1) under its Agenda Item 3 summarized the status of implementation of AMHS in the AFI Region. It was agreed by Decision 1/02 that a survey should be conducted in order to have a comprehensive situation of the status of implementation of AMHS as well as the ongoing planning of implementation by States/organizations:

Draft Decision 1/02: Survey of the status of implementation ATS AMHS in AFI

That, in accordance with the AMHS implementation Task Force Terms of Reference Composition and Work Programme, a survey should be conducted in order to analyze data on AMHS implementation status in the AFI region through a data collection format to be finalized by the secretariat

2. Discussion

Based on the information collected the Secretariat developed the table attached in **Appendix A** to this working Paper. It can be noted that AMHS systems are implemented with a low pace of establishment of international links.

Furthermore the Secretariat developed and circulated the Implementation table as attached at **Appendix B** that will replace Appendix A when completed in order to follow up the status of implementation of AMHS in the region.

- b) Update the status of implementation of AMHS in the AFI region by filling the tables of implementation
