# FPP History

- Established in October 2009.
- To support ICAO Assembly Resolution A36-23 and then A37-11 on PBN implementation, ICAO Asia-Pacific PBN Task Force recommended ICAO APANPIRG to establish the FPP.
- In September 2009, APANPIRG/20 meeting endorsed the concept.
- With supports from the Civil Aviation Administration of China (CAAC), the FPP office was established and located in Beijing, China hosted by the China Academy of Civil Aviation Science and Technology (CAST).

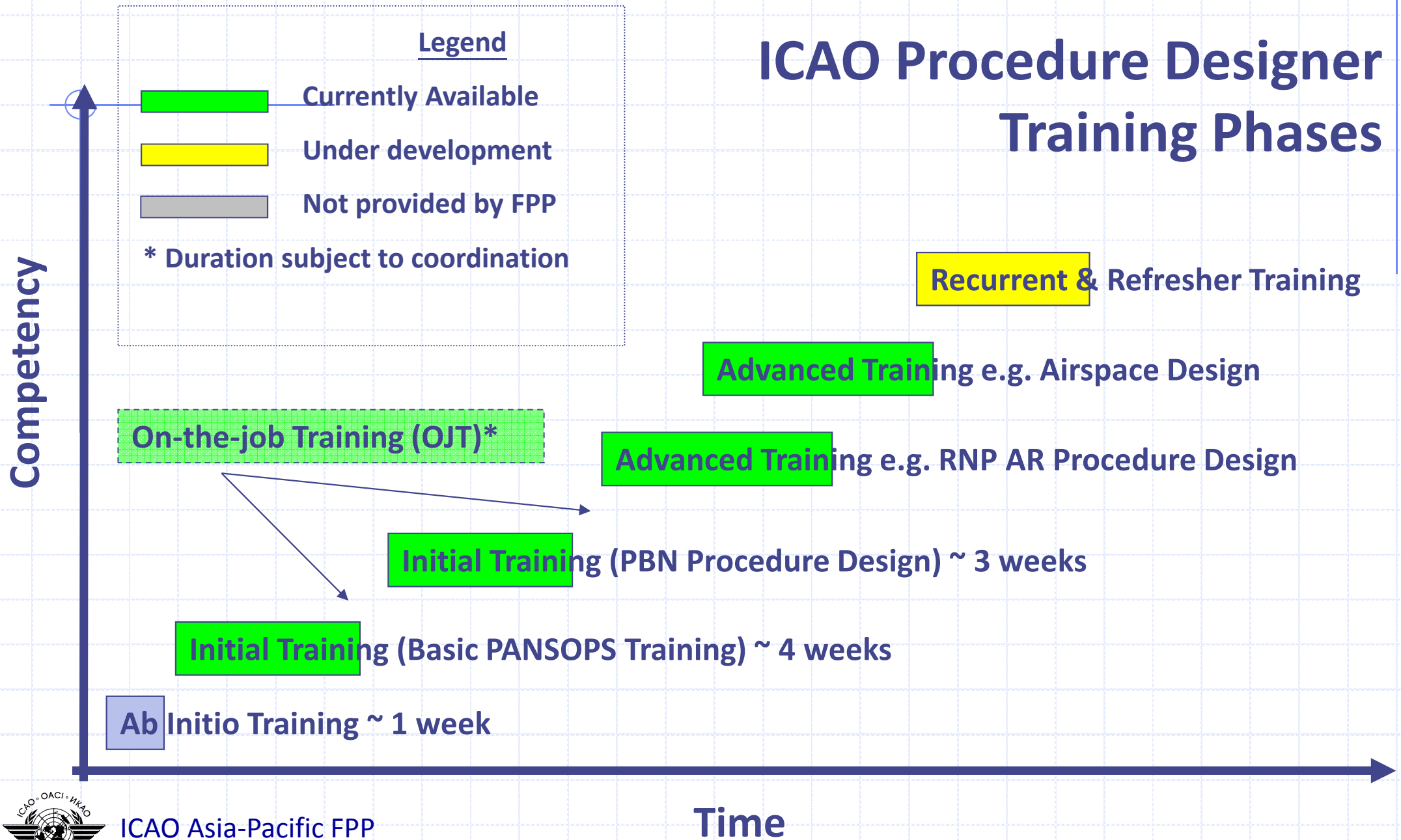

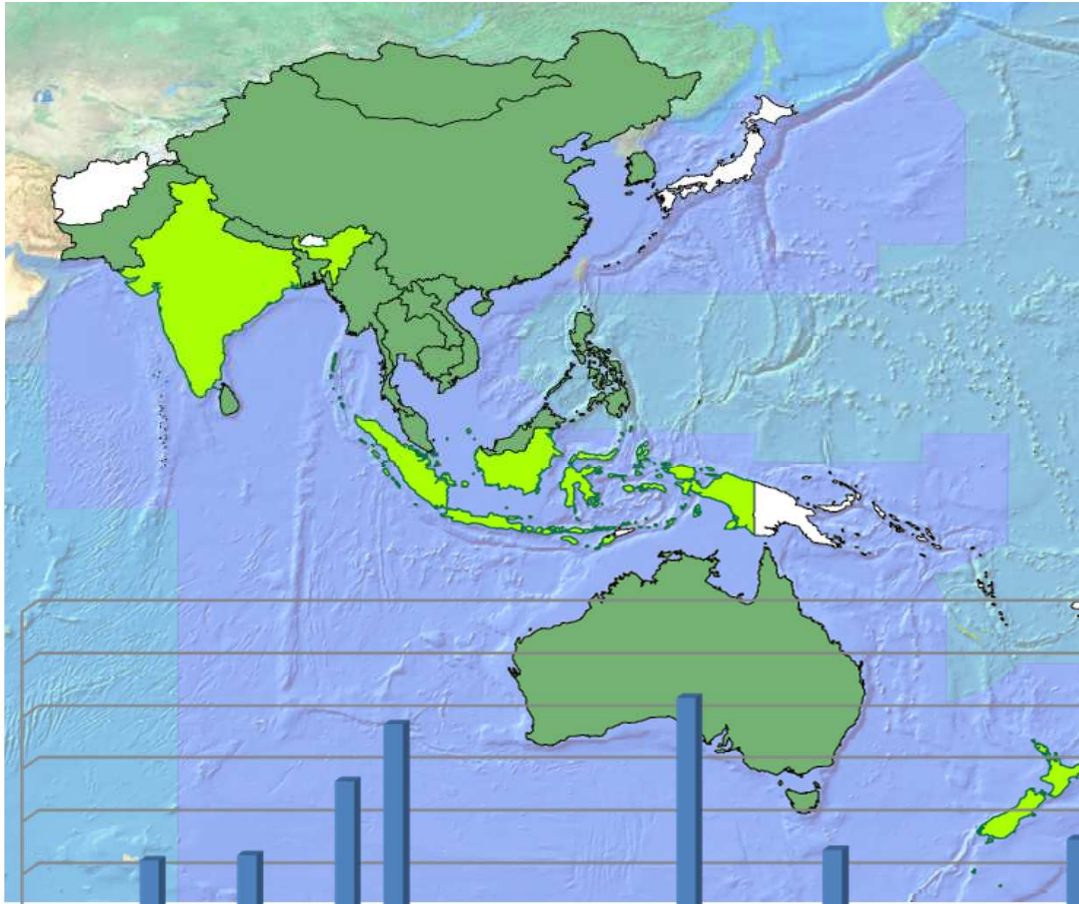




# Training Courses for States in 2011-2012

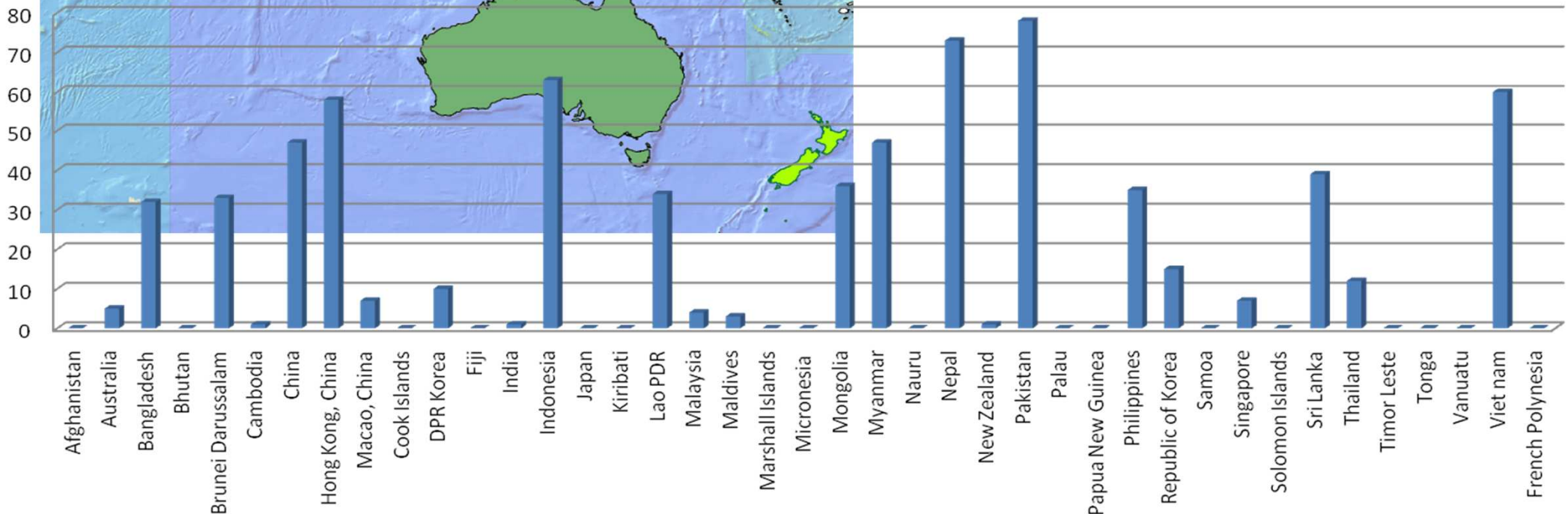

 ■ Member participation

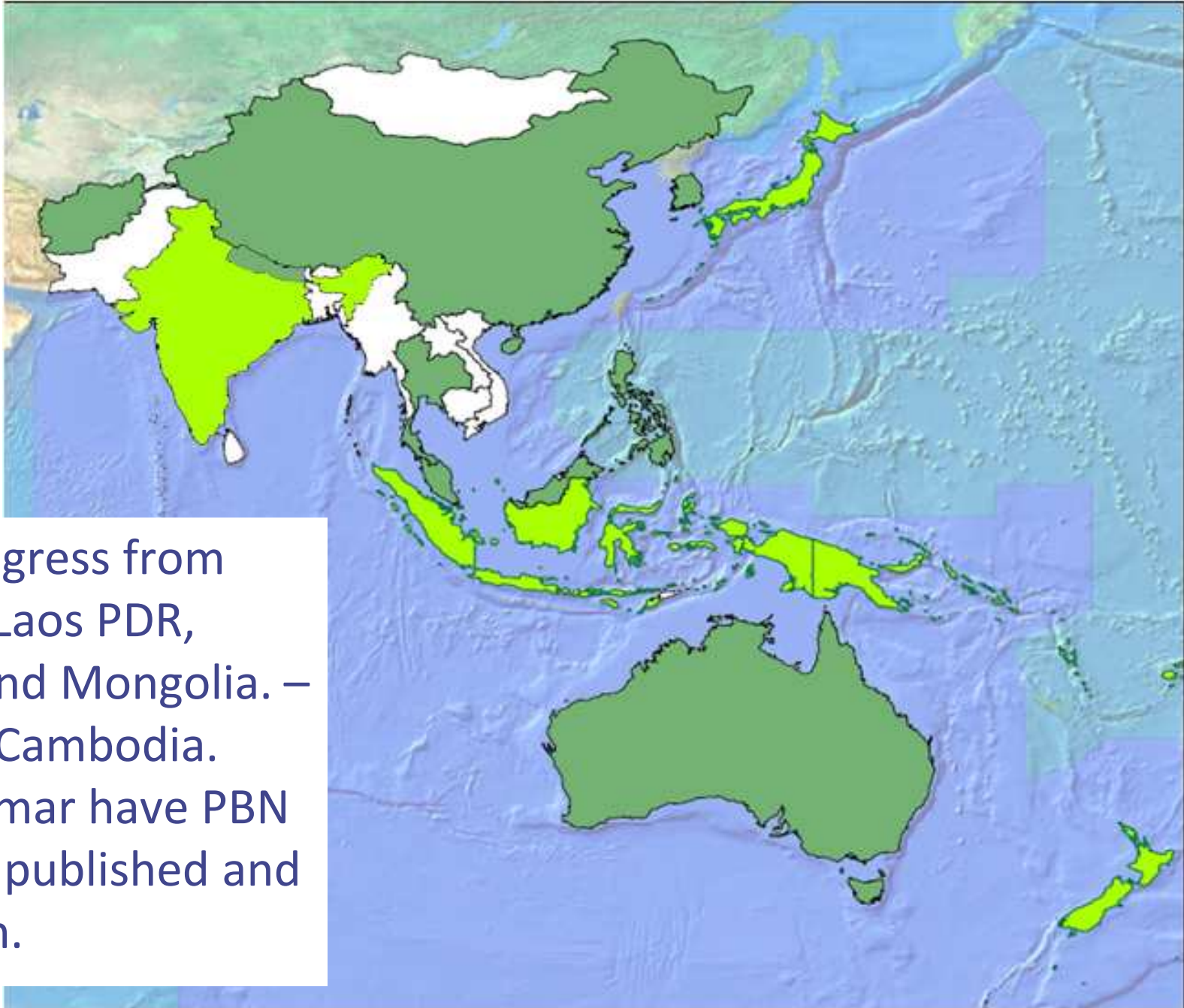
### Overall Training Participants

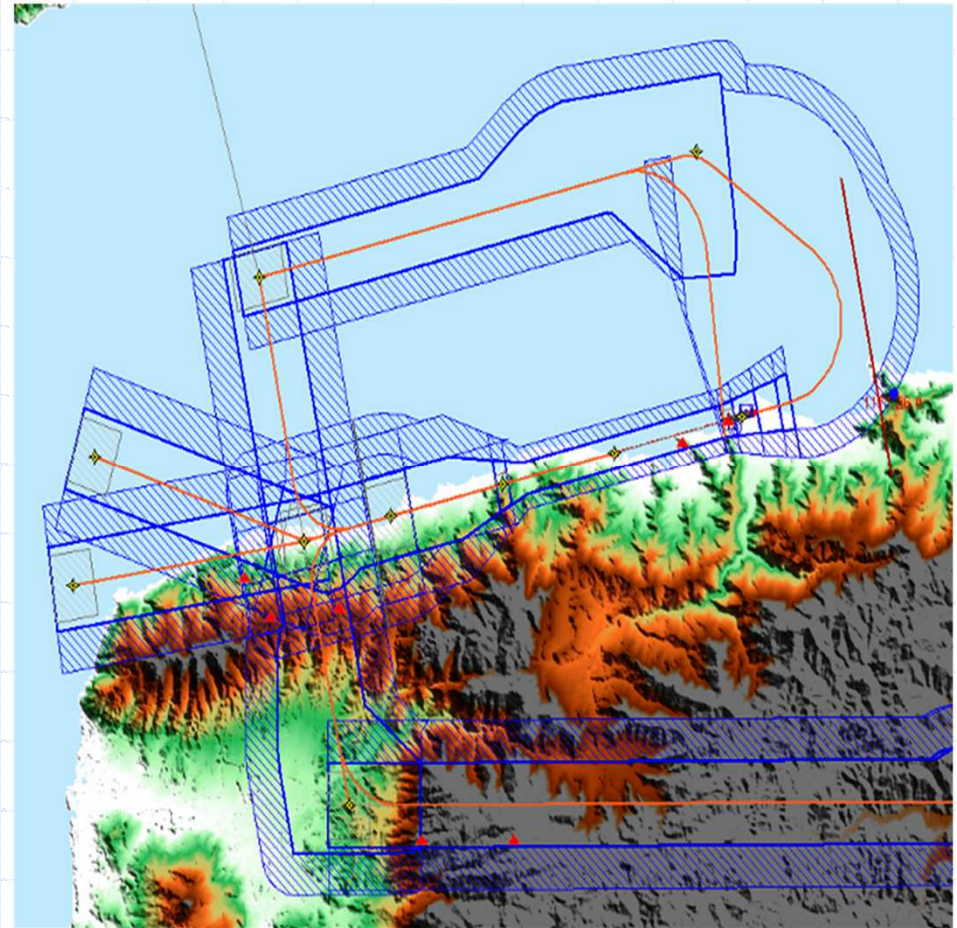

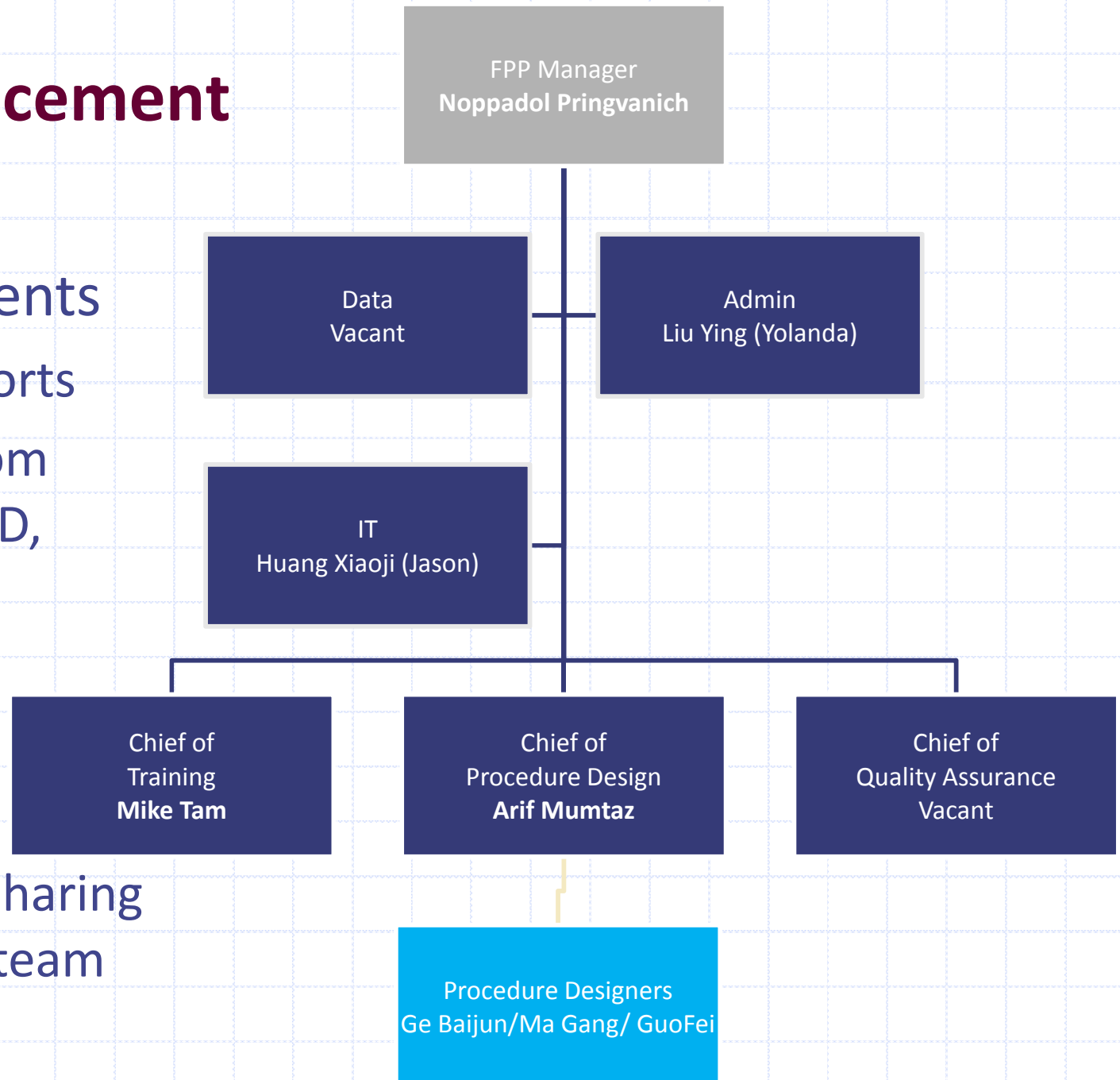


