The Training workshop will be conducted in English.

3. Opening Session

The opening session of the Training Workshop will take place on Tuesday 14 October 2014 at 09:00 hours.

4. Registration

The registration of participants will take place at the site of the meeting on Tuesday 14 October 2014 from 08:00 to 09:00 hours.

5. Documentation

The Training Workshop will be paperless and all related documentation will be on line at www.icao.int/WACAF/Pages/meetings.aspx and participants are advised to bring laptops for access.

6. Weather and Clothing

The average temperature in Dar Es Salaam is around 28°C.

7. Procedures for obtaining an entry visa for United Republic of Tanzania

For the case of visa delivery procedures, participants are requested to visit the Tanzania Immigration website www.immigration.go.tz for application forms and information on how to get visa before travelling. However, arrangement can be made to get the visa on arrival at Julius Nyerere International Airport (Dar Es Salaam) for those who will encounter any difficulty in obtaining visa while in their respective countries, provided that prior information (including list of such participants and their personal particulars relevant for visa application) are sent by email to the member of the hosting team at least two weeks prior to the date of travel.

8. Health

Participants are advised to have valid vaccination certificate. Inoculation against yellow fever and cholera are usually required in order to be granted entry into the United Republic of Tanzania.

Participants should also ensure that they have arranged for a valid health insurance for the coverage of any medical care during their stay in the United Republic of Tanzania.

9. Banks and Currency

Banks are located at the City Centre (within 2 km from the venue) and are opened from Monday to Friday from 08:30 to 15:30 and on Saturday from 08:30 to 12:00 hours. Local currency in Tanzania is Tanzania shilling (Tsh) and the exchange rate is approximately 0.0006 USD (i.e. 1 USD = 1,660 Tshs) subject to fluctuation.

10. Hotels

A list of recommended hotels is attached hereto and **participants are required to make their own reservation** on line direct to the hotel of their choice from the list of the hotels attached. Participants are informed that no transport service from the hotels to the meeting place will be made available.
