I. INTRODUCTION

In the framework of AFTN and ATS/DS communications between Lomé and its neighbors such as Accra, Cotonou and Niamey, two stations VSAT have been installed in Lomé.

ASECNA has installed in Lomé for long time a VSAT for communication between Lomé and other stations belong to ASECNA. Time being ASECNA has enhanced the VSAT links over its air space.

In 2004, GCAA has installed the GILAT VSAT in order to enhance AFTN and ATS/DS communication between Lomé and Accra. The maintenance of GILAT VSAT is done by the GCAA technicians in collaboration with ASECNA technicians in Lomé.

The current topic aims to outline Lomé VSAT links performance in term of AFTN and ATS/DS services availability throughout 2014.
