I have the honour to inform you that ICAO, in cooperation with the Singapore Aviation Academy (SAA), will be holding the Directors General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) Course on Aviation Safety immediately following the African Flight Procedure Programme (AFPP) Steering Committee meeting scheduled on 21 October 2015. The two-day DGCA course will take place in Praia, Cabo Verde, from **22 to 23 October 2015**.

This executive-level course will provide Directors General and Senior Government Officials of the African region with specific knowledge regarding the international civil aviation safety framework and its underlying principles, as well as the development of a national aviation safety framework that supports the development of civil aviation. This knowledge will enable DGCA to carry out their responsibilities to ensure the effective management of aviation safety in their respective States. The course outline is attached for your information.

The course will be conducted in English only.
