A, B & E	3	Implementation Coordination of ATS route trajectories	<p>The meeting will undertake the implementation of ATS Routes in the AFI ATS Route Catalogue (AARC). This will include trajectory alignment where necessary, to achieve the best efficiency results taking into consideration safety implications.</p> <p>States/FIRs will be expected to move expeditiously to implement the coordinated routes.</p> <p>It is advisable that, taking into consideration the priority trajectories agreed at PRND WG/4 meeting, concerned FIRs should bring copies of their LoPs for discussion in side meetings.</p> <p>The ESAF and WACAF Regional Offices will provide support with the allocation of 5 Letter Name Codes (5LNCs) and route designators for the trajectories. The meeting will also consider and propose solutions to implementation challenges identified.</p> <p>A limited consequential introduction of new ATS route trajectories could be introduced, pending on immediacy and time the meeting available.</p>
