Health

Weather and local time information

The month of September is **very rainy** in Douala with 25 rainy days. The minimum relative humidity is 76% and the maximum is 96% with the lowest temperature being **23** °C and highest temperature being 29°C. During that month Douala actually experiences a lot of line squalls with heavy rain.

Douala local time is GMT+1, It is fixed across the country.

Local Currency and Foreign Exchanges Rates

Credit cards and travellers cheques are accepted in most establishments. Most shops and hotels accept Visa Cards.

Language

The Official Languages of the Cameroon are French and English.

Hours of business

The working week in Cameroon runs from Monday to Friday (0730-1530hrs) with Saturday and Sunday being non official working days.
