Visas

Participants are advised to ascertain at the respective Embassies whether or not they are exempt from the Kenyan entry visa requirement. South African visas may be obtained from the South Africa High Commissions or Embassies. In applying for the visa, it is advisable to produce the letter of invitation from ICAO, together with other documents which may be required by the High Commission or Embassy. It is important to apply for visas well in advance to avoid delays and inconveniences. Participants should ensure that their travel documents and visa are valid prior to their departure to South Africa. **An appendix of Visa Requirements is attached herewith as Appendix-X.**

Hotel Information

A list of recommended hotels is attached herewith. Participants may make booking directly or communicate their preferred hotels to the local team to do the bookings on their behalf. All accommodation costs will be for the participant's account.

Health

Participants must ensure they obtain travel insurance from their home country for the duration of their stay in South Africa.

Weather and local time information

The month of June is mostly partly cloudy in Durban with a minimum of 3 rainy days. The average temperature in Durban in June is very mild at 16.5 °C (61.7 °F). Afternoons can be really warm with average high temperatures reaching 22 °C (71.6 °F). Overnight temperatures are generally quite mild with an average low of 11 °C (51.8 °F). The range/ variation of daily average temperatures in June is 11 °C (19.8 °F). The weather in June is somewhat parched with infrequent rain. A paltry 28mm (1.1in) of H2O is laid down across an average of 3 days. The skies in Durban are fine having on average a detectable 6:40 of splendid sunlight per day. The shortest day is 10:11 long and the longest day is 10:19 long with an average length of 10:13. There are approximately 3:25 per day when bright sunshine is absent due to cloud, haze or the sun being too low on the horizon to register. It is sunny approximately 66.1% of daylight hours and cloudy 33.9% of daylight hours. Additional information can be obtained online via:

Local Currency and Foreign Exchanges Rates

The official currency in South Africa is the South African Rand (ZAR).

The South African Rands exchange rates are determined by the interbank trade which varies daily. Participants may wish to obtain current information from the internet.

Commercial banks and forex bureaux provide exchange facilities. Most banks are open between 9.00 am to 4.00 pm from Monday to Friday and between 9.00 am to 12.00 noon on Saturdays. Some forex bureaus may be open outside these hours. Forex services are also available on arrival at King Shaka International Airport.



Credit cards and travellers cheques are accepted in most establishments. Most shops and hotels accept Visa Cards.

Language

The Official Language of South Africa is English.

Hours of business

The working week in South Africa runs from Monday to Friday (0730-1700hrs) with Saturday and Sunday being non- official working days.

Local Transportation

Taxis are available from the airport to the city center and the fare is normally between ZAR 250 to ZAR 450. However, it is advisable to agree on the fare before getting into the vehicle.
