Achievements during the 2021 WP

- Implemented the ICAO CART Recommendations(i-Parks)
- Enhanced coordination mechanism amongst the AFI SECFAL Plan partners (webinars, workshops, and meetings),
- Activities / programmes related to the Year of Security Culture (YOSC 2021)
- Strengthening of border controls, enhanced risk awareness and assessment,
- Improved oversight and quality control activities, establishment of sustainable funding mechanism



State Specific Projects

- 30 Days implementation of Phase One and Three for Djibouti was completed.
- □ Phase three for the Guinea Bissau Project was completed
- Tailored support for Central African Republic (CAR) was completed
- □ State specific Project for Mali started and is ongoing.
- Followed up on implementation of recommendations for concluded projects for Lesotho and Mozambique



Other milestones for 2021

- ICAO Annex -9 FAL virtual course (border control, NATFP, NATFC)
 41 AFI States (over 300 participants benefitting).
- USAP CAPs 13 Covered (Zimbabwe, Botswana, Rwanda, Uganda, Namibia, Chad, Equatorial Guinea, Gabon, Gambia, Guinea, Zambia, and Sao Tome.)
- CART FAL i-packs- 4 Covered (Gambia, Sierra Leone. Malawi and Eswatini.
- CART-AVSEC i-Parks 4 covered (Cameroun, Ghana Madagascar and Burundi




....milestones for 2021

- Supported the operationalization of API/ PNR, Threat Assessment Methodologies(TAM] in collaboration with partiners.
- □ Encouraged States to join the ICAO PKD (increased 1 15 States.
- Increased Collaboration/ joint activities with ACI, EU CASE Projects, IOM and UNCTED (counter-terrorism Programme) for API/PNR Systems
