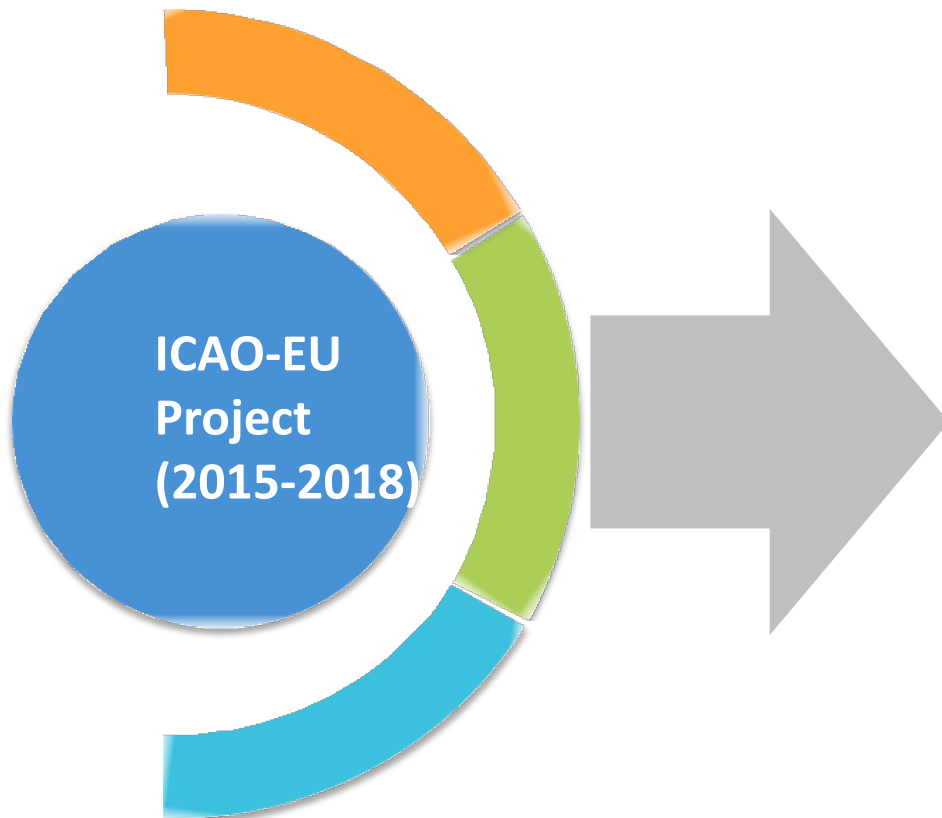

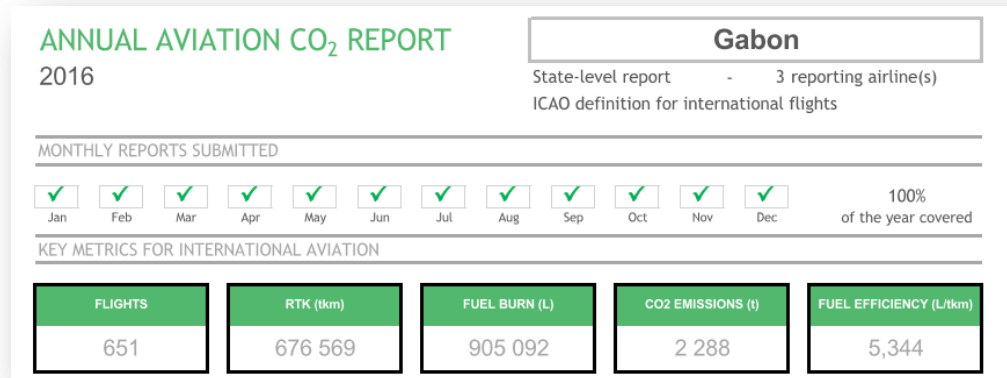

Implementation, within the framework of the ICAO-EU project, of the Continuous Climb Operations (CCO) and Continuous Descent Operations (CDO) at Libreville International Airport, including military and civil cooperation

Strengthening civil and military cooperation in the use of airspace with special status FOP2 and FOP3

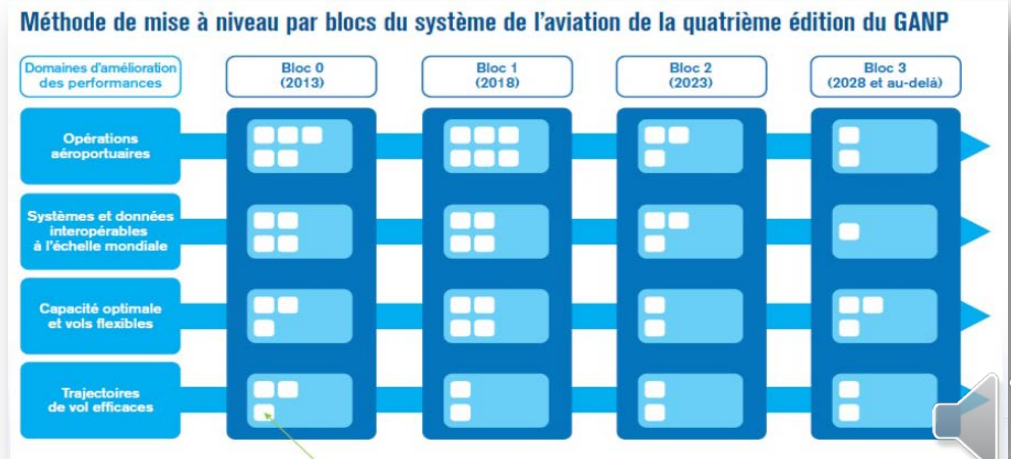
