LIMITED QUANTITY PROVISIONS FOR AEROSOLS

SUMMARY

This working paper proposes amendments to the Technical Instructions in order to address inconsistencies between limited quantity provisions for UN 1950 as indicated in Part 3;4.1.2 and Table 3-1.

Action by the DGP is in paragraph 2.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Part 3;4.1.2 only allows aerosols (UN 1950) of Division 2.1 and 2.2 without subsidiary risk to be transported under the provisions for limited quantities. However Table 3-1 allows the transport of following items under the provisions for limited quantities:
