SUMMARY

This paper proposes changes to Table 1-4 of the Technical Instructions.

Action by the DGP is in paragraph 2.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 At DGP/20, changes were made to the Key below Table 1-4 in the Technical Instructions to extend the training requirement to those engaged in the transport of mail and stores. However, although such changes were made to staff of category 5 and 8, no “x” was added against Limitations, to indicate this aspect of the transport of dangerous goods was relevant which, it is suggested should have been done because the provisions for dangerous goods in air mail (Part 1;2.3) are contained in Chapter 2 “Limitation of dangerous goods on aircraft”.

2. ACTION BY THE DGP

2.1 The DGP is invited to *amend* Table 1-4 as follows:
