SUMMARY

This paper proposes rewording of the provision of information requirements at cargo acceptance areas to highlight the necessity for visibility of such information.

4.7 CARGO ACCEPTANCE AREAS — PROVISION OF INFORMATION

An operator or the operator's handling agent must ensure that notices giving information about the transport of dangerous goods; are sufficient in number and prominently displayed; ~~and~~ ~~are~~ provided at a visible location(s) at the cargo acceptance points for cargo to alert shippers/agents about any dangerous goods that may be contained in their cargo consignment(s).
